YORK (WNS) -- The Democratic and Republican parties should make it clear that support of Israel is not a political issue "but an American position," Sen. Walter Mondale, the Democratic candidate for Vice President, stressed to about 60 Jewish leaders at a meet-

ing at the American Jewish Committee offices.
The Minnesota Democrat said that the U.S. must both support Israel and seek peace in the Middle East but not tie its aid to Israel to any blue print or timetable for decision. Mondale said Israel has declared that it will make peace and he argued the U.S. should not "crowd" or "push" the Jewish State but allow it to make its own decisions on a settlement,

As for the Palestinians, Mondale said "Israel should decide with whom she will nego-tiate. I don't think Israel can be criticized for refusing to negotiate with an entity that is not a state" and that calls for Israel's destruction,

Peter J. Strauss, president of the American Jewish Committee's New York Chapter, said the organization will also invite Mondale's Republican opponent, Sen. Robert Dole of Kan-sas, as well as President Ford and Jimmy Carter, to speak before the group,

In order to prove beyond any doubt that government belongs to the people and the people want what is rightfully theirs. Jack Tell decided to run for State Assembly in District Five. Unfortunately, it has not worked out that way.

It started with Alexander Hamilton's theory and policy that the powers of government should be dictated by those doing the governing, who were "the wealthy, the good, and the wise." Hamilton was opposed by Jefferson, the first great Democrat, who had complete faith that a people enlightened by education, could govern themselves better.

Down through the years, because of uncertainty, or unfamiliarity with the issues, or due to plain laxity, the voter has allowed himself to be coerced into electing figure heads. This led unscrupulous politicians gaining office for
