Yiddish Revival

The first World Conference in Israel for Yiddish and Jewish Culture should provide a welcome revitalization for Yiddish, a language whose death has all too often been prematurely reported. The fact that 500 delegates from throughout the world attended the conference and that 2000 persons attended the opening session should be proof that Yiddish is still alive and kicking.

The holding of the conference in Jerusalem and the support it received from the government of Israel is of more than passing importance. The use of Yiddish has been under attack in Israel going back to the pre-State days. There were two reasons. One was that many Zionists considered Yiddish the language of the Galut, and the second was the desire to establish Hebrew as the language of Israel.

Well now there is no question that Hebrew is firmly rooted in Israel. "Fiddler on the Roof" and the songs and poems of Itzhak Manger gave Yiddish a new respectability in Israel. The large number of Soviet Jews who came to Israel in recent years also increased the number of those speaking Yiddish.

In the United States, Yiddish had declined as the children of immigrants abandoned it in their desire to become Americanized. The same thing was true of the children of Jews who went to other countries, including Israel.

But now, when many Jews want to know about the heritage they abandoned in the rush to assimilate, Yiddish is having somewhat of a revival. Many American Jews are enrolling in courses in Yiddish at universities, adult schools and synagogues and Jewish centers. Many more are hungrily devouring the Yiddish books that are increasingly being translated into English.

Yiddish may no longer be the lingua franca of the majority of Jews throughout the world, but it will not die out either. The Jerusalem conference was proof that Yiddish as well as Hebrew -- and Ladino for the Sephardim -- is an essential tool of Jewish survival.

Libyan Terrorist Heads UN

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- "Exactly four years after the massacre of the Israeli athletes at Munich an accomplice to that crime assumes the presidency of the Security Council." Ambassador Chaim Herzog declared in a protesting letter addressed to Secretary-General Waldheim in connection with Libya's assumption of the presidency of the Security Council for the month of September.

Listed a long series of hijackings perpetrated by this enemy of humanity, Herzog reminded the UN chief that "Libya, a totalitarian dictatorship ruled by Colonel Qaddafi, whose hands are soaked in the blood of the innocent victims of international and Arab terror throughout the world, is a member of the Security Council. According to the Charter of the UN," he told Waldheim, the primary responsibility for the maintenance of international peace and

security' is that of the Security Council." Indeed, what blasphemy! Now we are to see the Big Powers along with the other members of this most important organ of the world organization sit around the horseshoe table beholden to what Herzog noted in his letter a "representative of a criminal regime. What more blatant example could there be of the systematic cynical disregard of the Charter of the UN than the fact that the representative of Libya, the paymaster and instigator of international terror," he charged, "will preside over the Security Council."

In his communication to Waldheim -- which has been circulated as an official document of the General Assembly and the Council -- Herzog noted further that "the list of crimes perpetrated by Qaddafi in the six years of his rule over Libya is too long to be cited in full."

After referring to Libya's link to the terrorist attack on passengers readying to board an El plane in Istanbul and to the hijacking of the Air France jet to Entebbe and to the very latest incident in Egypt, the Israeli Ambassador cited the following cases of hijacking and attacks on international airports:

September 8, 1971 -- Hijacking of a Jordanian Alia plane by a Libyan terrorist who was arrested but released after a few days.

October 29, 1972 -- Hijacking of a German Lufthansa plane by two terrorists who demanded the release of the murderers of the Israeli Olympic sportsmen in Munich. The hijackers found refuge in Libya where they were released.

April 9, 1973 -- Two units of the so-called 'National Youth Organization for the Liberation of Palestine,' financed and trained by Libya, carried out two attacks in Cyprus. One was against the residence of the Israeli Ambassador, and the second was against an El Al Israel Airlines plane in Nicosia Airport.

July 20, 1973 -- A Boeing 747 plane of Japan Airlines was enroute from Paris to Tokyo via Amsterdam and was hijacked by five terrorists and landed in Libya. It was blown up on July 24, 1973, while in Libya. The terrorists were later released by the Libyan authorities.

August 5, 1973 -- An indiscriminate massacre by terrorists in Athens Airport. Five passengers were killed and 55 wounded, most of them passengers from a TWA plane which had arrived from Israel. The terrorists stated that they were trained in Libya. They were released and flown to Libya.

September 5, 1973 -- An attack by terrorists using missiles against an El Al plane was foiled in Rome. Five terrorists were arrested... Three of them were released and flown to Libya.

December 17, 1973 -- Terrorists belonging to the Libyan sponsored so-called 'National Youth Organization for the Liberation of Palestine' attacked a Pan Am plane and a Lufthansa plane in Rome International Airport. 22 passengers were killed...

March 3, 1974 - A British plane en route from Beirut to Amsterdam was hijacked by terrorists, members of the Libyan sponsored terrorist organization. The terrorists blew up the plane after the passengers and the crew were

was going to do the telling.

Mr. Herzog further reminded the UN chief that "the murderers of the Israeli athletes in Munich on September 5, 1972 used Libyan diplomatic pouches for the transfer of the weapons to Germany, and that the terrorists who occupied the Saudi Arabian Embassy in Khartoum on March 1, 1973 and murdered the American Ambassador and other diplomats had used the Libyan diplomatic pouch for the transfer of their arms to Khartoum. After the murder, the terrorists were transferred to Libya.

What a blot upon this world organization, created to seek concord among states and combat crime and terrorism, that it accepts and tolerates the main instigator of global terrorism and murder as a member -- and now as president -- of its most important organ. "The time has been reached," Herzog notified Waldheim, "when the UN must take immediate and effective action."

With Egypt the latest state to become the victim of Libyan - initiated Palestinian terrorism, it is now quite certain that the United Nations will no longer be able to evade the hitherto - postponed agenda item on international terrorism. The 31st session of the General Assembly, opening here on September 21, will certainly be confronted and have to deal with the challenge now posed by Israel.
