SAMUEL MARGOLIES FOR ASSEMBLY 10

Proposing equal rights legislation for women and expanded social service programs, Assembly District 10 candidate Samuel Julius Margolies has joined ten other residents for the seat contest.

"I believe in equal justice and fair treatment under the law for all regardless of sex. The controversy about the Equal Rights Amendment is not clearly understood by all and there are some that oppose it because of fear and lack of confidence," he said.

"The consolidation issue is amazingly simple, yet very complex, if we go by the record of the past few years.

"Surely if consolidation will save revenue and end duplication of services, it should be implemented."

Margolies said he would like to see consolidation accomplished with the least amount of chaos and financial irresponsibility as possible.

A Nevada resident for 17 years, Margolies has worked as a dealer in Strip hotels, and currently is associated with CY Business Opportunities as a salesman.

He lives at 602 N. Royal Crest Circle, and his interests include religion, metaphysics and philosophy.

Margolies made a presentation during a public hearing on the east leg of the U.S. 95 Expressway where he said the cause

of world peace must be strengthened to insure someone would be around to use the proposed highway.

He said Nevada is considered a backward and materialistic state by many, but that the residents are capable of achieving great progress for Nevada.

Margolies also said he favored opening lines of communication between legislators and voters and keeping those lines open.

BILL KISSAM FOR ASSEMBLY 4

Bill Kissam, a Democratic candidate in Assembly District 4, said he will update a 1974 poll of District 4 voters to determine if the voters still feel the same on the legislative issued.

Bill and his wife Margie live at 1340 Scenic Way in Twin Lakes and have four grown children. He is a 23 year resident of Las Vegas and has lived in District Four for the past 12 years.

Kissam said the 1974 poll showed that "on many issues, the mandate of the people was clear; eliminate the sales tax on food and drugs, retain the Right to Work law, annual sessions of the Legislature, and in favor of the Equal Rights Amendment."

Kissam said he also favors increased aid to Senior Citizens, more support for the state educational system especially for special students such as gifted children and the disabled, and more funding to fight crime in special directions that have already proven their worth.

Kissam received a Bachelor of Science degree in Business

Administration, with a minor in Political Science, from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas in 1972.

ciation of Clark County, past president of the United Methodist Men's Club, treasurer of Hi-Noon Toastmasters Club, and co-counselor with his wife Margie of the United Methodist Youth Fellowship.

He is a former member of the Daylite Lodge Masons, the Veterans of Foreign Wars and the American Legion which he joined after discharge from the U.S. Navy.
