

Fifty-one year old Ward Zimmerman of 361 Upland Blvd. has filed as a Democratic candidate for Assembly District Three.

Zimmerman said he is seeking his first political office because "I got so mad I finally decided to do something."

"One thing that irritates me thoroughly is when the legislature mandates the local governments for certain tasks without providing the funding needed," he said.

Zimmerman said he personally feels women should have the same rights as men, but said he would prefer to see an Equal Rights Amend-

ment on the state level where it could be closely examined. He said he would vote for it, however.

He said he has no objection to consolidation provided it is by a referendum of the people and the legality of it is determined before it is worked on. He also said any consolidated government should consist of all governments in an area.

Zimmerman said he is concerned with the parole and probation system where stronger laws are needed. He also believes court-appointed attorneys should be funded by the state. He also said gun

control laws are not the answer to crime in the streets, although punishment should be greater when guns are used in the commission of a crime.

He said he would like to see sales taxes taken off groceries. He also said local city and county governments are not getting their proper share of tax revenue from ad-valorem taxes. "Presently the local entities are in dire need of funds, whereas the state seems to be in excellent financial shape," he said.

Zimmerman also believes there is a strong need for some type of binding fact finding when
