WASHINGTON -- B'nal B'rith has denounced a Soviet propagandist for promoting anti-Semi-tiam and contended that "anti - Semitism re-

tiam and contended that "anti - Semitism re-mains a Kremlin political ploy." David M, Blumberg, B'nai B'rith's president, accused Dr. Valery Yemelyanov, a member of the Znanie (Knowledge) Society, as "the most outrageous big - lie specialist against Jews we've learned of in recent years." Blumberg said that Vemelyanov in the guise

Blumberg said that Yemelyanov, in the guise of a "acientific specialist," charged Zionists with being anti-Semites seeking to dominate the world and that their "strictly secret frame-work" included "almost all the presidents and parliaments of the developed capitalist coun-tries, and especially those of the U.S." Other "similar absurdities," Blumberg said, were claims that "80 percent of the economy and 95 percent of the mass media in the capitalist world are Zionist owned," that Zionists are the secret owners of foreign oil companies in Arab

secret owners of foreign oil companies in Arab countries and are conducting "anti-Semitism terrorism" in the Soviet Union to provoke Jews to emigrate.

Yemelyanov also described the Torah as "the blackest book" ever created and disputed Juda-

Blumberg said the significance of Yemel-anov's activities was not so much his "obscene absurdities" as his role as a lecturer, since the content of such lectures require approval by Communist Party officials.

Blumberg added that lectures are exceeding-ly popular in the Soviet Union, in one recent

ly popular in the Soviet Union, in one recent year drawing more than a billion persons, ac-cording to the Communist Party. Soviet emigres say lectures "are a power-ful force in the Soviet Union" and are "much more believable than the press." Blumberg said that Yemelyanov's lectures and writings -- he is also on the faculty of the Maurice Thorez Institute for Foreign Lan-guages in Mowcow -- were being promoted by the guages in Mowcow -- were being promoted by the Palestine Liberation Organization.

In an interview published by Falastian al-Thawra (Free Palestine) in Beirut, Yemelyanov, claiming that Zionism and anti-Semitism were "two sides of the same medal," called for a world-wide coalition, begun by the Russians and Arabs because "our enemy and your enemy are the same," to fight Zionism. The lecturer prethe same," to fight Zionism. The lecturer pre-dicted the struggle would be "extraordinarily bloody."

Blumberg said that B'nai B'rith would pro-test to the Soviet Union.




