

PERES OPPOSES CAPITAL PUNISHMENT

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Defense Minister Shimon Peres said he was opposed to capital punishment of terrorists. He said in a radio interview that he was proud Israel is the only country in the Middle East where death penalties are not carried out.

Since the Air France hijack some persons in Israel have argued that terrorists should be executed to provide less incentives for hijackers to hold hostages in order to demand the release of imprisoned terrorists. Justice Minister Haim Zadok told the Knesset that the Cabinet had discussed the issue two years ago and had decided to refrain from carrying out death penalties. But he said the Cabinet was free to change its policy in the future.

In the radio interview, Peres rejected a proposal by Likud leader Menachem Beigin to establish special counter-terrorist squads to battle terrorists. Israel's

present defense force is capable of handling terrorists, Peres asserted.

GOLDMANN PREDICTS MORE PRESSURE ON ISRAEL

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- No matter who is elected President of the United States this year, increased pressure will be put on Israel to withdraw to its pre-1967 borders with only minor modifications, according to Dr. Nahum Goldmann, president of the World Jewish Congress.

He told a press conference here that his prediction was based on a belief that the United States was fed up with the Middle East problems and wants a final settlement because both the U.S. and the Soviet Union want to end the status quo because of fear of a new Mideast war and the Arab realiza-

LAS VEGAS ISRAELITE HADASSAH TO COMBAT ASHKENAZI DISEASE

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Mucopolipidosis IV, a newly-discovered genetic disease that apparently primarily affects Ashkenazi Jewish children will be combatted by the National Foundation for Jewish Genetic Diseases, Inc., and Hadassah.

This was announced by Faye L. Schenk, chairman of the Hadassah Medical Organization at Hadassah's 62nd annual convention here. A team of doctors from Hadassah Hospital in Jerusalem have been working for three years in delineating the

new genetic disease whose earliest clinical sign is a cloudy cornea in newborn babies or young infants. Later, toward the end of the first year, psychomotor retardation becomes apparent.
