## Capehart in Assembly race

Neal Capehart, 23, of 4425 Stacey Ave. has filed as a Republican candidate in Assembly District One.

Capehart was defeated by Juanita White in the 1972 University of Nevada regent race. He said he is running for assemblyman because of citizen dissatisfaction over government.

"I saw some of the things done during the last session of the legis'ature," he said. In the assembly there is a large amount of "kowtow-ing". "You know who has been bought and paid for and by whom," he claimed.

Capehart, who is em-ployed at the Nevada Test Site, said he is "griped about the way the Attorney General's office handles bribery of legislators. We know it's been going on, but no one has been tried for it." he said.

He also said he would like to see the judicial system revised. He suggested a procedure used in Massachusetts where 18-year-old offenders are put in the maximum security prison for 30 days before they see the judge. This does not give them enough time to

get used to the jail, so they are scared to death, he said. And they then promise to be good. It cuts down on repeat offenders, he explained.

Capehart said he would vote for the Equal Rights Amendment because he likes to the idea of equal rights. However, he said the logical thing to do would be to get the Supreme Court to decide how it would affect Americans before it is passed.

He supports consolidation which is a "wonderful

### EGYPT'S UNDERGROUND DEITY AT UN

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- If symbolism means anything, Osi-ris, the 'Egyptian God of the underworld and the judge of the dead' (Webster's dictionary), took a place here dictionat the UN.

At a ceremony held in the Delegates' lobby close to the entrance of the General Assembly Hall, Egyptian Am-Abdel Meguid presented a 2,700 - year old statuette of the delty to Secretarythe General Kurt Waldheim for permanent display.

In his presentation Mr. Meguid speech, omitted any reference to Webster's definition of the underground and the "dead" and instead said that Osiris the husband of Isis, was supposed to have been a prophet who "pacified and civilized the world, saving it from barbarism, by persussion and music as opposed to violence and forceful means, It may thus be said," he stated, "that Osiris was one of the earliest philosophical harbingers of the Nations."

Relating the myth Ostris' violent death, diamemberment and ultimate resurec-tion, Meguid queried: "Is not the death of the League of Nations and the subsequent coming into being of the United Nations a modern re-affirma-tion of the legend of Omiris?"

The gilded bronze statuette shows the god holding the emblems of ruling in both hands and wearing the ate-crown. Set on a wood-en base, it is 47.5 cm high,

Osiris becomes the second ancient idol to enter the UN halls. The first was Zeus. chief of the Olympian gods and husband Hera, Presented nd husband of Presented by the Greek Government some years ago, it stands life-size in the
