

### DR. L. HAMMARGREN FOR REGENT D

University faculty members should be offered yearly opportunities to further their education and should be reviewed on their progress, according to Board of Regents candidate Dr. Lonnie L. Hammargren.

He said the review system would work in conjunction with the tenure system and would not replace it.

"They should spend a month during the summer in required education that would be supported by the state and then a month teaching and then the third month for vacation," said the 38-year-old neurosurgeon.

"No one in this world has tenure—not the best president or the best neurosurgeon. In medicine, we have to report that we've taken x-number of classes every year for the rest of our life to remain certified," he said.

Hammargren is running in District D, which includes Henderson, Boulder City and most of the outlying parts of the county. He is challenging board Chairman James "Bucky" Buchanan of 6163 S. Pecos Road and Bill Cramer of 5091 Champions Ave.

He and his wife, Barbara, and their three children reside at 4318 Ridgcrest Drive.

The candidate said he would be receptive to faculty members who want to

In response, the regents voted to maintain the construction of the Charleston Heights campus as the first priority but set construction of a Henderson branch as the fifth priority. The priority list will be considered for funding by the 1977 Legislature.

Hammargren also said he supports the expansion of the medical school at the University of Nevada, Reno, into a four year school. He also wants more health sciences programs and more doctorates offered in various fields.

In addition, he is promoting a new field house for athletic activities at the University of Nevada, Las Vegas.

He is a member of the UNLV Rebel Booster Club and the Rebel Athletic Foundation.

He has a great interest in astronomy. He is chairman of the board of directors of the Clark County Community College Planetarium. The planetarium will be added in a new campus building to open this fall. He is chairman of the board of Southern Nevada Concerts Inc. and a board member of the March of Dimes.

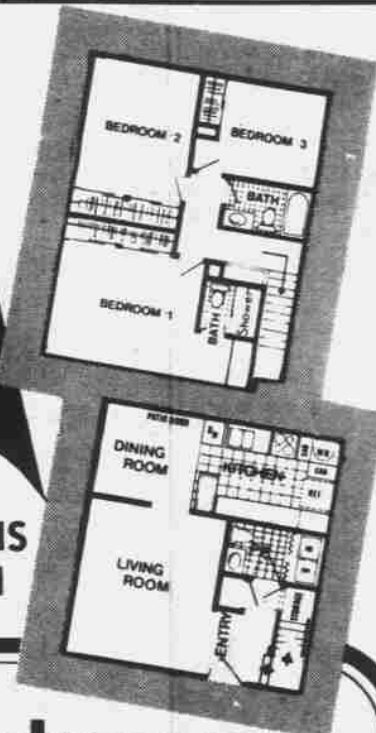

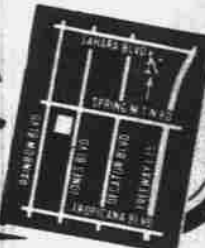
