

BOB WHITE FOR COMMISSION B

Bob White, 34, a businessman for the last 12 years in Clark County, has filed as a candidate for seat B on the County Commission in the upcoming elections.

A Democrat, White emphasized a need for concentrating on "people issues" and said consolidation can be considered later.

"We seem to be staggering on people issues," he said, "such as public health and welfare." "Consolidation can wait. It's time to think about all citizens of Clark County."

A lifelong resident of the county, White has been active in the Jaycees and Boy Scouts. He attended Woodbury College and UNLV.

While filing, he said, "I not only care about the bulk population area of Clark County, but I also care about the outlying, integral communities throughout our county, and their importance."

NASH SENA FOR ASSEMBLY 21

Assemblyman Nash Sena, 37, has filed for reelection as a Democratic candidate for District 21. Upon filing Sena said, "I will continue to be a representative of my constituents and not be drawn into the current mold of a typical politician and make outlandish promises that I cannot keep nor fulfill."

As a first term legislator, Sena strongly feels that changes must take place within our state legislative process in order to keep up with the demanding responsibilities of managing our growing state.

He said "Our state budget and problems within our state are certainly not on a decline. Our state budget for the next biennium will come close to the one billion dollar mark and this is one of the many reasons we should consider the feasibility of having annual sessions."

Sena presently is a member of the interim legislative subcommittee studying the problems of the Senior Citizens and the nursing facilities of Nevada. He thinks that our priorities

should be reevaluated and that more consideration be focused on our elderly.

Sena said that he would request legislation on abolishing the sales tax on food for the elderly. He said the request for a community college in Henderson is not unreasonable considering the increased enrollment of students attending classes in Henderson in the past several years. He pledges to do everything possible to see that Henderson is given consideration for a campus.

He is an elementary school teacher for the Clark County School District, a 22-year resident of Henderson and lives at 144 Victory Road with his wife, Twila, who is a contact representative for the U.S. Immigration Service. They have no children.

chance to ratify a vital amendment to the constitution extending the principle of equality our country is based on."

Calcaterra says many candidate-critics of the E.R.A. who insist the amendment is "too vague" are "vague themselves." He points out that they always stop short of explaining exactly what they disagree with. "With this kind of stand, they can still say they are in favor of the principle and think they won't anger the E.R.A. people too much, and at the same time, draw the support of people opposed to it."

Calcaterra urges the general public to be wary of such statements from candidates. "Pin them down on the issue. Make them tell you exactly

what bothers them about it. Chances are they're really either strongly opposed to it (in "principle" or otherwise), or just don't know very much about it. I'm constantly surprised at the number of politicians who don't know that the amendment they are so critical of is only three sentences long."

Rick Calcaterra has promised that if elected, passage of the Equal Rights Amendment in Nevada would be his highest priority in the next legislative session.
