

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- The Cabinet has approved the naming of Asher Yadlin, the 55-year-old head of the Histadrut's Kupat Holim Sick Fund, as the governor of the Bank of Israel when Moshe Sanbar's term ends next month.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Israel security forces uncovered two Fatah terrorist groups in the Nablus area.

LONDON (WNS) -- A revision of the Soviet Union's law on religious association, adopted this year, makes Jewish religious and cultural life in the USSR more difficult, according to the Institute of Jewish Affairs here.

LONDON (WNS) -- The International Institute for Strategic Studies in its new report "Military Balance 1976 - 77" says Israel has five submarines.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Arab owners of land near Ramallah have decided to accelerate their construction of buildings despite a military ordinance prohibiting such construction without special approval by the military governor.

LONDON (WNS) -- Leon Dulzin, treasurer of the Jewish Agency and World Zionist Organization, said here that Jewish solidarity is needed not only in the diaspora but Israel as well.

CHICAGO (WNS) -- "Almost all Russian Jews want to emigrate," Dr. Vitaly Rubin, the noted Soviet Jewish authority on ancient Chinese philosophy, told a press conference sponsored by the Jewish Federation of Metropolitan Chicago.

PARIS (WNS) -- Louis de Guiringaud, who was appointed Foreign Minister in the shakeup of the French government, has been a stalwart supporter of a role for the Palestine Liberation Organization in world forums during the more than two years he headed the French delegation to the United Nations and is expected to continue the French policy of hostility to Israel and support of the Arabs.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Bomb explosions heavily damaged two synagogues and a drug store in a predominantly Jewish neighborhood in Buenos Aires.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- The Senate is sending a special committee to Israel, Egypt, Iran and Europe to study U.S. foreign policy with a particular emphasis on nuclear proliferation.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Federal Judge Henry Werker of the Manhattan Southern District Court, will be asked to apologize for ordering a spectator to remove his yarmulka or leave the courtroom.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Two Fatah terrorists received life imprisonment from a military tribunal and a third a 15 - year sentence for a series of sabotage acts.

ATLANTA -- Hamilton Jordan, National Campaign Manager of the Carter/Mondale Presidential campaign, announced the appointment of Ed Sanders to the post of Deputy National Campaign Director. Sanders is a member of the National Executive Committee of the United Jewish Appeal and vice - president of the Council of Jewish Federations and Welfare Funds. He resigned as President of the American Israel Public Affairs Committee to accept the post with the Carter/Mondale campaign.

NEW YORK -- American Jewish military personnel and their families in such far-flung locations as Japan, Germany, Korea, Spain, Greece, Turkey, Italy and the Philippines will be able to observe the High Holy Days and have their special religious needs met by Jewish military chaplains, civilian and Reserve rabbis and military lay leaders through arrangements made by the Commission on Jewish Chaplaincy of JWB.

ZOA HOUSE, NEW YORK -- Dr. Joseph P. Sternstein, speaking at the opening session of the 79th Annual National convention of the Zionist Organization of America, described the issue of the boycott of Israel and of companies with Jewish employees as "The critical litmus test of support for American Jewry and the State of Israel."
