#### RABIN SAYS RUSSIA PREVENTS PEACE

JERUSALEM (WNS) Premier Yitzhak Rabin has charged that the Soviet Union prevents the reconvening of the Geneva peace conference on the basis of the original invitations extended to the parties in the Middle East conflict by the Secretary General of the United Nations following the Yom Kippur War.

The Russians have adopted a policy of total support for the most extremist Arab states, Rabin said on a television interview. He made his remarks when asked if Israel's apparent interest in keeping the Sovier Union out of Middle East diplomatic ac might not make activity that country a sworn enemy of Israel.

Rabin said, "To the best of my knowledge, it is the Soviet Union through

decided that policy, Israel would be sworn enemy not Is-rael that decided this." sworn He said the Soviets were the main supporters of the PLO.
"If the Soviet Union continues to cling to its extremist anti-Israel policy, I see no reason why Israel need be interested in its initiatives," Rabin said.

On the other hand, he reiterated that Israel prepared negotiate an overall peace settlement with the Arabs at Geneva on the basis of the original invitations or alternatively, to seek agreements with its neighbors to end the state of war.

## Historic Event

The day of August 24, 1976 will be remembered in Jewish history as marking the end of a struggle between Hebrew and Yiddish.

On that day there began a 4 ference in Jerusalem dedicated to the glori-fication of the language known as "mama Lashon" (mother's tongue). Wags say it's so called because the father can't get a word in edgewise. "Tatte Lashon," father's tongue, that is,

Hebrew, won the victory over Yiddish when Zionism opted for the language of the Bible over the language of the Jewish masses as an official tongue of the Jewish land.

Yiddishists were peeved over that choice, but they must marvel over the fact that Hebrew is the only language in history which has been resuscitated as a national parlance.

Yiddish has often been disparaged, as a jargon, which it is not. Its literature matches in splendor that of any language. It has often been mourned as dead, which it is not. Millions still

speak it and enjoy it. Hebraists and Yiddishists have been at odds, with Israelis especially downgrading the latter.

But on August 24 that feud ended. Over 400 delegates from 16 countries assembled for a series of lively sessions extolling Yiddish, Re-solutions called for its greater use in Israeli schools, for organizational support of its newspapers and periodicals, for the establishment of a Yiddish theatre in Israel, etc.

Main organizer of the conference was a Zionist leader, Isaac Korn. Yitzhak Rabin, Golda Meir, a cluster of high Israeli officials and litterateurs from the world - over graced the conference Simon Weber, the editor of the Yiddish Daily Forward, said the most glittering address at the meet was by a Conserva-tive rabbi, Dr. Arthur Hertzberg, the gifted president of the American Jewish Congress.

#### SENATE ADOPTS ANTI-BOYCOTT BILL

(WNS) --WASH. Senate The adopted by a 65-13 vote a bill extending the Export Administration Act which included four provisions aimed at combatting the Arab boycott.

Opponents of bill, il Republicans, led by Sen. John Tower of Texas, and two Democrats, James Allen of Alabama and James Abourezk of South Dakota, centered most of their criticism on the mandatory disclorequirements claiming it would in-terfere with trade,

The provisions prohibit compliance with the Arab boycott demands, requires dis-closure by American companies of compliance with foreign boycotts, prohibits American firms from discriminating against other U.S. firms in other U.S. firms in order to aid nations at war with countries friendly to the U.S. and prohibits U.S. com-panies from discloscoming information about the racial or religious makeup of their ownmanagement.
