NEW PLAINSMEN, SHERRY BRYCE HEAD LANDMARK'S COUNTRY MUSIC SHOW

The Jubilee Showroom of the Landmark Hotel is "comin' on strongly country" with some of the biggest singers, comics & musicians on the country scene today. Headlining the country jubilee are The New Plainsmen and Sherry Bryce, with Sherry's band, Proud Country and super-picker, Skip De Vol. Special guest star is Pat Buttram.

The New Plainsmen are making their Las Vegas debut as such. The vocal foursome -- two of which are from the original Plainsmen -- lays down a pleasant mixture of up-tempo, hand-clappin' tunes

and smooth, mellow ballads featuring the abysmal bass of Gerald Williams.

Sherry Bryce's first Las Vegas appearance was on May 12 of this year; at which time, she exchanged wedding vows with Mack Sanders, owner of the largest country music radio chain in the world, in an airplane circling the city! Sherry has many hit singles to her credit, among which are "Don't Stop Now," "Love Song," "Pretty Lies" and her latest recording "Everything's Coming Up Love," which is scheduled for release October 5. Working as a duo, she and Mel Tillis released chart-ringers "You Are the One," "Mr. Right & Mrs.

Wrong" and "Living & Leaving" and were nominated "Duet of The Year" by the Country Music Association.

TV's most engaging cornfed con - artist (the loveable Mr. Haney of the "Greenacres" series), 15-year sidekick of Gene Autrey in films, and one of the nation's funniest after-dinner speakers, Pat Buttram

returns for the third time to the Jubilee stage. Buttram can never be accused of stealing a joke -- 90% of the time, he wrote it in the first place. The rural monologist has also, in recent years, come into his own as an outstanding dramatic actor, having appeared in Alfred Hitchcock television thriller and in the motion picture "Twilight Of Honor."

Skip De Vol's incredible banjoistics have made him a nearly permanent fixture at the Landmark, where he never fails to amaze audiences with his flying fingers, original arrangements and varied repertoire. The Country Music Salute is in the Jubilee Showroom through October 3, followed by Le Roy Van Dyke October 4 through October 24.
