WORLD JEWRY CAN INFLUENCE UN

Chaim Herzog, Israel's Am-bassador to the United Nations, believes that if world Jewry demonstrates an interest in the proceedings at the UN it will cause a diminishing of the anti-Israel tone of the world organization.

"I am convinced that if Yugoslavia or Cuba, for example, feel that the Jewish people will react very strongly against their anti-Zionist outburst, they will change their tune," Herzog said in tune," Herzog said in an interview. He noted that "our attacks on Libya as the center of world terror have brought Libya to disclaim publicly terror-ism and hijacking and created a situation whereby the hijackers of the KLM plane to Cyprus had nowhere to go."
