Multi TONY AWARD winner RON FIELD staged and directed Chita's new act for the Versailles Room...... MERV **GRIFFIN** and company back for another week of special "Las Vegas weeks" at Caesars Palace, and once again, Merv proves he is this town's number one Goodwill Ambassador.
