Dick took his portion of the show to Hawaii and turned a floating Chinese - American Restaurant, located at Pier 6 in Honolulu Harbor, into a major Island tourist attraction.

It's 550 - seat Empire showroom could be doubled in capacity without Jensen having to worry about playing to an empty seat. That's how strong "The Giant" is in the Islands.

Of course, in Hawaii, Jensen does a full hour - and - fifteen minute show as opposed to the 30 - plus minutes he's doing at the Sahara. And what a show it is!
