

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- Enraged over the anti - Palestinian statement made by the Lebanese Ambassador before the General Assembly, Kikhia of Libya, expressed sorrow and pain at hearing a representative of an Arab country at the UN saying things that sadden us and undermines our cause.

ATLANTA (WNS) -- Beatings administered to 12 Soviet Jewish activists by Soviet police after a sit - in October 18 at the Supreme Soviet in Moscow drew the wrath on October 19 of Jimmy Carter, the Democratic nominee for President, and of the National Conference for Soviet Jewry and the Student Struggle for Soviet Jewry.

NEW YORK -- Declaring that "the advancement of peace in the Middle East will create a historic opportunity for the Technion to play a crucial role in developing the technology, in elevating the economic infrastructure and in raising the general standard of living of the masses in the entire Middle Eastern area," Joseph J. Sisco, former Under Secretary of State for Political Affairs and now President of American University told the 400 persons attending the National Dinner of the American Technion Society that there will be "a fresh opportunity in 1977 for the U.S. to take the lead in Middle East diplomacy."

NEW YORK -- The American Jewish Committee today expressed gratification at a "productive meeting" between Committee leaders and Argentinian statesmen during which the Argentinians voiced strong opposition to recent anti-Semitic manifestations in their country and promised vigorous countermeasures.

CAMBRIDGE, MASS. -- Already acclaimed in its Hebrew version, the English edition of A HISTORY OF THE JEWISH PEOPLE, written for a general audience by six leading scholars at the Hebrew University in Jerusalem, will be published by Harvard University Press on October 29.

PHILADELPHIA -- Dr. Abraham I. Katsh, Distinguished Professor of Hebraica Research at The Dropsie University, is the only scholar from the United States invited to participate in the Congress of Linguistics and Hebrew Scholarship to be held at the University of Vienna, Austria, from November 2 to 5.

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- Assessing the root causes of the Lebanese crisis, the outgoing Christian President Suleiman Franjiah, in a farewell broadcast on Radio Beirut on September 19, charged that "the Palestinians have deceived Lebanon and are today deceiving the other Arab States" which, he stated, "will suffer the evils of the Palestinians as Lebanon itself has suffered."

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- The first major attack against Israel was launched here last week by the Foreign Minister of Iraq, Saadoun Hammadi, who reverted to the year 1947 when the General Assembly adopted the partition resolution sanctioning the State of Israel.

WASHINGTON, D.C. -- Arab efforts to equate Zionism with racism have backfired among Christian groups in the United States, according to a survey made public by the American Jewish Committee.
