ments to Soviet offi-cials about the meetings, Funseth said he couldn't say,"The Funseth Soviet Union is very much aware of our position on Soviet Jews," he stated.

Meanwhile, more than 40 Jewish activists issued a statement in Moscow appealing "to all those who support the struggle of Soviet Jews for free emigration to Israel" to action to foil latest moves by Soviet authorities to discredit and destroy the Jewish emigration The movement. statement was received in New York by the Greater New York Conference on Soviet Jewry which translated it and released it. At the same time, the GNYCSJ reported that many of the signers are now imprisoned. The state-ment said, in part, that the beatings re-present "the most example of the vivid pogrom atmosphere enforced in the country."

CARTER FOR ISRAEL (Continued from Page 1) against discrimination.

Carter's slim victory over President Ford was helped by Jewish voters in such key states as New York, Pennsylvania and Ohio. The Jewish vote nationwide was estimated to have been 75 percent which was midway between the 85 percent Sen. Hubert H. Humphrey received in 1968 and the 65 percent given Sen. George Mc-Govern in 1972. This was also the estimate of Carter headquarters in Atlanta. But Ford's campaign headquarters estimated that the President received about 35 percent of the Jewish vote. In New York City where a heavy plurality won the state for Carter, the Democratic candidate received 80 percent of the vote. Carter did very well in heavily Jewish areas of Brooklyn, Manhattan and the Bronx. However, Democrat Daniel P. Moynihan garnered even a larger percentage of the Jewish vote in defeating incumbent James Buckley in the U.S. Senate race in New York, Carter won 70-75 percent of the vote in the heavily Jewish areas of Philadelphia. Carter's headquarters in Atlanta said that the former Georgia governor won 80 percent of the Jewish votes in Cleveland Heights. But a breakdown of 13 heavily Jewish districts in three Cleveland suburbs showed Carter win-ning by a slim margin. Carter also received about 70 percent of the Jewish votes in the Miami area and Boston. In Michigan, the Jewish vote was split fairly evenly despite the heavy Demo-cratic registration of Jews. Some saw this as appreciation for Ford's longtime support of Israel while he was in the House of Representatives. , mmmmmmmmmmmmmmm
