

**COSTA RICA JOINS ISRAEL ON PRO-ARAB DRAFTS**

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- On the voting of two pro-Arab resolutions dealing with the Pales-

tinians in the Special Political Committee debating UNRWA last week, Costa Rica was alone in casting her vote with Israel against the drafts.

The first resolution, entitled "Population and Refugees Displaced since 1967 calling upon the Assembly to reaffirm the right of the Palestinians to return to their homes and camps in the occupied territories and which deplored Israel's refusal to take steps for their return, was adopted by a vote of 101 in favor to 2 against with 2 abstentions (Malawi and Papua New Guinea). 40 were absent. Among the Western states voting for the resolution was the United States.

The second draft, entitled "Palestine Refugees in the Gaza

Strip" and which calls upon Israel to force those refugees who have happily moved into modern and sanitary housing to return to the unsanitary shacks of their former slums was also adopted by a similar vote, but this time the U.S. joined Papua New Guinea in abstaining. Malawi was among the absent states.

**DAYAN SAYS ISRAEL SHOULD TALK TO ARAFAT**

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- The Israeli Government should talk to Palestine Liberation Organization head Yasir Arafat in order to help the Palestinians achieve a national homeland in Jordan, former Defense Minister Moshe Dayan said in a television interview.

"It is necessary

to speak with the enemy even if we have no compromise proposal," Dayan said, "Otherwise, it will be impossible to reach a settlement."

Meanwhile, the Knesset is expected to take up the propriety of a recent meeting with PLO representatives in Paris by several pro-

minent Israelis, including a former MK and a former official of sub-Cabinet rank. Neither the Israelis nor the PLO could agree on a basis for a future meeting during the get together which was held in a private home. The Israelis who participated included Meir Payil of Moked; Re-

serve Gen. Matityahu Peled, a lecturer at Hebrew University; Dr. Yaacov Arnon, former director general of the Finance Ministry who is presently chairman of the board of directors of the Israel Electric Corp., and Uri Avneri, publisher of the weekly magazine Haolem Haze,
