

UNESCO CONDEMS ISRAEL'S POLICIES

PARIS (WNS) -- A resolution condemning Israel's policies in the occupied territories was adopted by UNESCO's Program Commission November 18 by a 73-7 vote with 30 abstentions, according to a report received here from Nairobi, Kenya.

The resolution must now be adopted by the plenary session of the UNESCO general conference, but it is believed unlikely that the vote will be

changed. The resolution said that UNESCO condemned Israel's policies "as contrary to human rights and to fundamental liberties, all violations resulting from the Israeli occupation, of the rights of the Palestinians living in all the occupied Arab territories to national education and cultural life.... particularly by a systematic policy of cultural assimilation."

U.S. - ISRAELI DIALOGUE TOP PRIORITY

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The first priority in the Middle East is for an American - Israeli dialogue to discuss the terms of a settlement for the Arab-Israeli conflict, former Foreign Minister Abba Eban told a press conference. He said that until the new Carter Administration is set up "it's premature to talk about the Mid-

Rep. Albert Quie (D. Minn.) a member of the United States delegation which voted against the resolution, said the condemnation will make it more difficult for Congress to approve paying the \$38 million the U.S. owes for its 1975-76 dues. Congress refused to pay U.S. dues to UNESCO after Israel was expelled from the world agency two years ago.

But it was expected to reverse itself because of the general conference's decision which will allow Israel to rejoin the European region of UNESCO.

The press conference was sponsored by Tel Aviv University's newly established Institute for Policy Planning and Strategic Studies of which Eban is chairman. He said the new institute will meet the "need for new thinking about the central problem of Arab - Israel peace."
