stressed, "condemns the Committee for being one-sided, biased, intellectually dishonest and expedient and for allowing itself to become a tool in the hands of the PLO. The Committee has thus enabled the PLO to transplant the nihilistic aims of its Covenant into a UN document."

Mr. Herzog then cited several clauses from the PLO Covenant which call for the setting up of a Palestinian state under the guerrilla leadership in all of 'Palestine' including King Hussein's domain of Jordan and he scored the Committee of 20 for having completely and deliberately ignored any references in its report to this Covenant "which could be described only as a Nazi racist document."

In referring to the PLO role in the ruination of Lebanon, Ambassador Herzog let the Assembly know that "the West Bank is now awake and fully recognizes the murderous character of the PLO." In this context, he quoted the former Mayor of Hebron, Sheikh Muhammed Ali Al-Jaabari, as having made this statement on October 14:

"As long as there is a body called PLO which behaves in the way it does, there will be no solution to the Palestine Question. I think that the Arab people of the West Bank should be brave enough to admit this, courageous enough to know what is in its true interest. This people should authorize Jordan to negotiate on its behalf, so that afterwards it will have the opportunity of self-determination."

The tragedy in all this lies in the fact that, in the face of the Western power's seemingly reluctance to accept the historic truth and reality as propounded by Ambassador Herzog in his address, "the Arabs can muster an automatic majority and thus have the General Assembly at their command." Let the world organization know, Herzog warned, that "no dictated solution will be accepted by Israel" and that "without face to face negotiations based on mutual recognition and respect conducted in a civilized manner, there will be no advance toward any accommodation."

So I wrote him a blessing. And, sure enough, he responded to my note in a most gracious fashion.
