TERESA BREWER, JIM BAILEY, RIP TAYLOR IN SAHARA SHOW

Teresa Brewer, Jim Bailey and Rip Taylor have combined their individual talents into one of the most exciting shows ever presented in the Sahara Hotel's Congo Room.

Miss Brewer demonstrates a marvelous feel for any type of song, be it her early - 50's rock hits or the sophisticated music of today; Jim Bailey stops every show cold with his uncanny illusions of Phyllis Diller, Barbra Streisand, Judy Garland and Peggy Lee; while Rip Taylor just tears the place apart with his indescribable nuttiness. It all happens twice a night, at the 8 o'clock dinner show and again at the midnight cocktail performance.

Teresa Brewer's youthful appearance belies her years of experience as a top recording star in the rock and roll days, with dozens of guest appearances on all the variety TV shows, and more recently as a headlining concert and nightclub performer. Her repertoire has broadened to include country, show, jazz and contemporary selections, and she handles them all with equal ease.

Her infrequent Las Vegas appearances (because of the demands of a family of four active daughters) only serves to increase the demand to see her, and she doesn't disappoint her audiences.

Jim Bailey brings

a bit of magic to each of his characterizations. Meticulous in every detail of costume, hair style and make-up, his depictions of Diller, Streisand, Garland and Lee have amazed even those very same performers. Bailey's opera-trained tenor voice captures those ladies' own sounds to perfection, and not content with that, he reappears as himself to demonstrate his own delightful vocal style in an "equal time" segment.

Rip Taylor's part of the show is almost impossible to review, for he rarely does the same combination of corny one-liners and outrageous sight gags twice in a row. His unbelievable props and costumes put him in a class by himself and his rapid-fire asides ("Is the mike on?", when a gag misses) keep the showgoers weak with laughter.

Brewer, Bailey and Taylor will remain through December 7.
