

NEVADA LUNG CAMPAIGN SEEKS \$1000,000 TO BENEFIT NEVADANS

The 1976 Christmas Seal Campaign officially opened in Nevada. More than 180,000 letters containing Christmas Seals have been mailed to the homes of Nevadans by the Nevada Lung Association.

Bob Rose, Lt. Governor and Nevada's Christmas Seal Chairman said, "Christmas Seals have become a tradition in Nevada since the early 1900's. People look forward to receiving Christmas Seals each year and using them on holiday mail."

Rose said the goal for Christmas Seals in Nevada is \$100,000 to fight lung diseases. The personable Lt. Governor added that all monies raised through Christmas Seals this year will remain in Nevada to be used locally. "In the past, 96% has remained here in Nevada for local programs, but this year is an exception because research money is being returned to Nevada by the American Lung Association to study the tissue structure of the lung. We will retain 100% of all contributions to benefit Nevadans directly," said Rose.

Bob Rose said, "The more you can give to Christmas Seals, the more we can do for you. It's a Matter of Life and Breath."

AGAINST SYRIAN TROOPS NEAR ISRAEL

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Premier Yitzhak Rabin has strongly warned that Israel "will not tolerate" a move by the Syrian army into South Lebanon or the use of the region as a terrorist base against Israel.

"Israel will feel free to prevent southern Lebanon from becoming a terrorist base against us, as it was before the onset of the civil war in Lebanon," he told the opening session of the convention of the World Council of Synagogues November 23. He said Israel's reaction to any development in South Lebanon will be decided only by Israel. However, Rabin stressed that Israel will not interfere in the internal affairs of the Arab country as long as

they had "no impact on the security of our citizens and settlements."

The Syrian forces have reportedly stopped their drive into south Lebanon.

Israel meanwhile has built up its men and military equipment along the border with Lebanon. Israeli sources have expressed the hope that the Lebanese army could be stationed between the Israel border and the Syrian troops as a sort of buffer zone.

RABIN URGES SADAT FOR DIRECT TALKS

JERUSALEM (WNS) Premier Yitzhak Rabin has urged Egyptian President Anwar Sadat to hold direct talks with him on a

Middle East peace settlement.

Rabin told a closed dinner meeting of the World Union for Progressive Judaism's Jubilee Conference at the Knesset November 21 that Israel was encouraged by the talks about peace from the Arabs.

"What is not encouraging is that the word (peace) is never addressed to us," Rabin said. Directing his remarks to Sadat, Rabin declared: "I have heard what you have had to say to others. Now what do you have to say to us. You have explained your willingness to make peace with American Senators, Congressmen and other visitors. You have talked about peace with NBC, CBS and

ABC. If you are serious about peace let us negotiate. Please let me hear from you."
