LIBYA DESTROYS RESOLUTION AGAINST TAKING HOSTAGES UNITED NATIONS

(WUP) -- Libya, the main culprit here at the UN, has thrown a 'monkey - wrench' into a West German proposal of the "Drafting of an tional International Convention Against the Taking of Hostages," the debate on which recessed last week pending a final vote by the Sixth dealing Committee with Legal affairs. The draft resolution, sponsored by Austria, Central African Republic, Co-Costa Rica, lombia, Denmark Ecuador, West Germany, Iran, Italy, Liberia, Nepal, Netherlands, Surinam, Sweden, Turkey and Venezuela, has called Sweden, for the creation of a - member ad hoc 35 committee to draw up a convention against the taking of hostages.

Libya, the leading nation which has given and is giving sanctuary to terrorists and hijackers, introduced two amendments which would all but destroy the basic intend of the resolution.

One of Libya's amendments would following delete the words from the opera-tive paragraph re-questing the drafting of the convention: of the convention; "...on the basis that the taking of hostages should be condemned,

prohibited and pun-ished and that perwho perpetrate sons such acts should be prosecuted or extra-

dited for the r of prosecution." The other Libyan amendment would in-

nocent" before the word "hostages" contained in six graphs of the six paradraft resolution.

Nun, gimmel, hay and shin read the Hebrew letters on each side of the dreidel. They are the initials of Ness gadol haya sham -- "A great initials of Ness gadol haya sham --miracle happened here."

It is the miracle of the oil that burned for eight days that Jews throughout the ages have commemorated in their celebration of Chanukah, the "Festival of Lights." This year Chanukah will be commemorated worldwide beginning Thursday evening, December 16, Friday, December 24.

The eight - day holiday is celebrated in memory of Judah Macabee, who with his small band of religious zealots, was victorious over the tyrannical forces of the Graeco-Syrian ruler, Antiochus Ephphanes in 165 BCE.

In an attempt to create a unified realm loyal to the Crecian culture, Antiochus deprived Jews of religious freedom.

He so far succeeded that his armed forces installed an idol in the Temple in Jerusalem and appointed Jewish apostate priests to sacri-fice swine to the Greek God in the courts of Solomon.

Antiochus made it a capital crime throughout Palestine to teach the Bible or circumcise boys. His army went through the country, installing idols and apostate priests in every village, and was unopposed at first by the stunned and cowed populace.

Later, the Jews refused to accept this ulti-matum and fought for freedom of religion. During their struggle, the small army of the Maccabees, led by Judah and his brothers, was vic-torious over the Syrian Army. Following the recapturing of the Holy Temple which had been desecrated by the Syrians, the

Macabees prepared to rededicate the sanctuary to God.

On entering the temple, they found that the Greeks had defiled all the oil. Only a small bit remained, and it seemed only enough to keep the menorah lit for one day. Yet the oil burned for eight days, and the kindling of the Chanukah lights celebrates this miracle.

On each night, one more light in the menorah is kindled, beginning with one candle on the first night of Chanukah and ending with eight on the final evening. The ninth branch is reserved for
