This is one episode in a gripping book put out by Bloch Publishing Co. in which a cluster of relatively young people tell us what it is like to remember the horrors of Hitlerism or to live with parents who went through that inferno.

Entitled "Living After the Holocaust," book includes essays, poetry, dialogues, teaching techniques offered by the contributors, many

of whom are on college faculties.

One of the offerings is by Hans Herda, who grew up in a Nazi home but converted to Judaism, probably out of a sense of guilt. Now living in Lexington, Mass. Herda warns that we not yield to the desire of blacking out the memory of Nazism.

The book's two editors, Lucy Steinitz and

David Szonyi, engage in a symposium with others who ponder the impact of the Nazi experience on their lives and the lives of their parents.
