

POLAND, U.S. AMATEUR BOXERS AT SAHARA AUG. 13 AT 11 A.M.

Poland's national boxing team will bring its 14-man squad, under sanction of the Amateur Athletic Union, to Hotel Sahara's Space Center on Saturday, August 13, to compete against the USA national team composed of top boxers from this year's AAU championships.

This meeting has been an annual affair since 1973 and the Sahara is honored to be the first stop on this three-city tour (Detroit and Hartford are the others.)

Three members of the Polish squad were medalists in the '76 Olympics, Jerzy Rybicki (gold), Leszek Blazynski (bronze) and Kazimierz Szczerba (bronze).

The Americans, with a 30-man squad, are training at Nellis Air Force Base and are confident that they will make a good showing against their highly-touted foes.

Colonel Don Hull, boxing administrator for the AAU, sees the card as a "good line-up" and describes the American team as "young but tough."

At 105 pounds, we have Israel Acosta of Milwaukee; 112, Jerome Coffee of Nashville; 119, Rocky Lockridge of Tacoma; 125, Johnny Bumphus of Seattle; 132, Sammy Ayala of San Antonio; 139, Tom Hearn of Detroit; 147, Roger

Leonard, Washington, D.C.; 156, Clinton Jackson, Evergreen, Ala.; 165, Lindell Holmes, Toledo; 178, Charles Singleton, Philadelphia; and heavyweight Greg Page of Louisville. All but Holmes and Singleton are AAU champs.

There will be bouts in 11 weight classifications and current national AAU champs will be scheduled

to represent the U.S. in nine of them. The bouts are scheduled to begin at 11:15 on Saturday, August 13 in the Sahara's Space Center and will be televised live for ABC's Wide World of Sports. Advance tickets (\$5 and \$10) will be available at the Sahara casino cage on Wednesday, August 3.
