Secretary of State Cyrus Vance and Egyptian President Anwar Sadat to hold a meeting of Israeli and Arab foreign ministers in the United States this fall to prepare for a Geneva Conference was welcomed by Premier Menachem Begin August 3.

The proposal was unveiled by Sadat August 2 after two days of talks with Vance. The U.S. Secretary, who appeared in a press conference in Alexandria, Egypt, with Sadat, said he would try to persuade Syria, Jordan and Israel to join Egypt in a working group that would meet under U.S. auspices in Washington and New York in September.

Begin described the idea as "very constructive" in a interview on Israel Radio. He said he had proposed the same idea during his trip to Washington but would not criticize Sadat for claiming credit.

Noting that Sadat's proposal means that Egyptian Foreign Minister Ismail Faymy and Israeli Foreign Minister Moshe Dayan would be sitting at the same table, Begin said, "This is something to welcome." The major stumbling block to acceptance of the idea is Syria where President Hafez Assad has declared that he would not support any plan that excludes the Palestine Liberation Organization.

Vance was in Syria August 4 in an attempt to persuade Assad. In Washington, former Secretary of State Henry Kissinger told a reporter that the working group is the best way to prepare the ground for a Geneva Conference. "I recommended a working group at the United Nations in September of 1975," he asserted. But he said he was "not in favor" of including the PLO in the talks.
