SADAT ASKING JEWS TO RETURN CALLED "HYPOCRISY"

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Egyptian President Anwar Sadat's invitation to Jews who formerly lived in Egypt to return there is "nothing but hypocrisy intended to mislead public

opinion," the World Organization of Jews from Arab countries charged here.

Norma Balass, WOJAC'S executive director, noted that in 1947, Egypt's United Nations representatives threatened

the Jews living in Israel with massacre. "The Jews from Egypt will never again let Egypt make them hostages of Arab brutality," she said.

Balass noted that only five percent of Egyptian Jews were ever given Egyptian citizenship. She

claimed that there were 80,000 Jews in Egypt in 1949 and there are now only 400.

"The government of Egypt went to great lengths to make sure that the Jews left stripped of all their possessions," she said.

WEST BANK SETTLEMENTS PEACE ASSETS

NEW YORK (WUP) -- "I believe the West Bank Jewish settlements could become an asset rather than a detriment to a solid peace in the Middle East."

Thus declared writer Walter A. Sheldon in a recent letter published in The New York Times.

"There are hundreds of thousands of Arabs living as Israeli citizens in pro-1967 Israel," Mr. Sheldon observed. "Once peace is established and Israel's right to exist is beyond question, I do not see why Jews should not be able to live peacefully as equal citizens of Arab countries...I do not see any reason why the Jewish settlements

in areas to be ceded to the Arabs in a peace settlement should be dismantled."

Sadat said that he flatly rejected Vance's proposals that a Geneva agreement incorporate normalization of relations between Israel and its Arab neighbors. He also insisted that Israeli withdrawals from occupied territories be completed within six months of signing a peace treaty not in gradual stages over a period of five years as proposed by the Carter Administration. Sadat said he has alternatives in his mind to deal with the question of PLO representation at the peace talks, something which Israel has categorically rejected. He disclosed he received a message from PLO leader Yasir Arafat reminding the Arab states that they had agreed at the Ramat summit meeting in 1974 that the PLO was the sole legitimate representative of the Palestinian people.

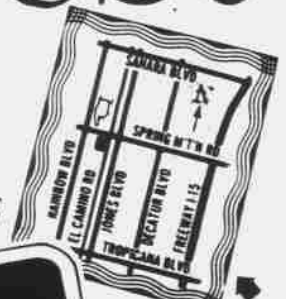
