## FRANCE LEANS TO ARABS ON ANTI-BOYCOTT LAW

PARIS (WNS) -- An anti-boycott law which was approved by Parliament June 7 was overturned last week by the government when it decided that the law will not be applicable to Arabimposed restrictions on trade with Israel.

The government issued an "executive directive" instructing the state - controlled Foreign Trade In-surance Commission that the law does not cover French in the Mideast. trade The law. proposed opposition and majority members of Parliament, outlawed all boycotts based on religion, national origin or race and in-cluded a paragraph enabling the government's ment's counter-mand-ing directive noted that "In order to balance out foreign trade and halt unemployment the country's export drive
must be considered
a national priority."
