

BIBLE JOINS FIRST WESTERN



SEN. ALAN

Former United States Senator Alan Bible has been elected to the board of directors of First Western Financial Corporation and its subsidiary, First Western Savings Association. Announcement of the acceptance by Bible was made by Frank E. Scott, chairman of the board of FWF, and Maj. General R. G. "Zack" Taylor, chairman of the board of First Western Savings.

"I have had the pleasure of working with Senator Bible on countless problems and challenges involving the growth of Nevada," Scott said. "He has been a longtime personal friend, and we are honored that he is once again prepared to devote his vast experience, expertise and wise counsel to the continued growth and development of Nevada."

Bible, who served in the Senate for 20 years before retiring in 1974, was a ranking member of the powerful Senate Appropriations Committee and was second in seniority on the Interior Committee. In these positions he secured hundreds of millions of dollars for water and mineral development, public lands, parks, recreation, wildlife, reclamation projects, Indian projects, highways and increased development of the Nevada Test Site and state defense installations.

Anticipating a crisis in energy, Bible authored and became known as the "father" of geothermal steam development legislation.

Bible was Storey County district attorney and Nevada attorney general before his election to the Senate in 1954.

He was named a Distinguished Professor of Political Science by the University of Nevada, Reno, where he lectures in advanced political science courses.

ORGANIZED CRIME IN ISRAEL???

JERUSALEM (WNS)
Ehud Olmert, a 31-year-old Likud MK who has studied the Israeli underworld, has charged that organized crime exists in Israel and claims he has the documents to prove it.

He called for a parliamentary investigation. After Olmert's charge Police Inspector General Haim Tabori met with Interior Minister Yosef Burg to discuss plans for dealing with crime. Tavori said in radio interview that to speak about or-

ganized crime was an exaggeration but the police did have a file on a number of suspects. But he said it was difficult to prove their guilt.

Meanwhile, Shmuel Nahmias, who recently resigned as the police's chief intelligence officer, charged that the present police structure was incapable of dealing with organized crime. Olmert meanwhile is engaged in a dispute with Reserve Gen. Rehavam Zeevi, former commander of the army's central commander and an advisor to

former Premier Yitzhak Rabin on anti-terrorism. The MK accused Zeevi of threatening him following a charge by Olmert that "senior army officers" were involved in organized crime.

Zeevi has announced he is suing the MK for libel. Olmert said that he did not claim that Zeevi was involved in organized crime but that the general was a friend of Bezalel Mizrahi, of Tel Aviv, one of Israel's most successful building contractors who has been accused of being involved with criminals. "Mizrahi is a very good friend of mine," Zeevi said. "If he is involved with the 'Mafia' then I have a problem. But I don't believe he is."

Haaretz charged that Mizrahi, a fifth generation Sabra is the financier of many of

JERUSALEM JEWISH POPULATION DECLINING

JERUSALEM (WNS)
-- Housing and Construction Minister Gideon Patt said here that his ministry would make every effort to raise the growth rate of the Jewish population in Jerusalem to 3.7 percent a year.

He said that rate is needed if the present ratio of 73-27 percent Jews to Arabs is to be maintained. Patt said the rate has not been at 3.7 percent since 1973 and that this year's figure is expected to be 2.3 percent.

The Housing Ministry built 14,800 apartments in Jerusa-

lem during the past 10 years, 11,100 of them in new neighborhoods, according to Patt.
