"equalization" which will be paid by the Israeli government since the West Bank and Gaza residents pay a relatively low tax rate based respectively on Jordanian and Egyptian law. He stressed the government was not changing the legal system and said that for this reason Israel's system of free and compulsory education could not apply in these two areas. Asked specifically if the new policy was a step toward annexation, Naor said that would be "interpretation."

Begin's coalition government has pledged the total integration of the West Bank and Gaza into Israel "when the time is right." But he has indicated he will not act on this as long as diplomatic negotiations with the Arab states continue.

Meanwhile, Defense Minister Ezer Weizman has announced that 100 Arab prisoners, some convicted criminals and other security offenders, are being released as a gesture for the Moslem holy month of Ramadan which began August 15.

**U.S. OPPOSES CHANGING RESOLUTION 242**

WASH. (WNS) -- The United States is "basically opposed to altering or amending" United Nations Security Council Resolution 242, State Department spokesman Hodding Carter declared August 16.

Carter said the resolution adopted after the 1967 Six Day War is a "matter carefully wrought" and "to try to amend that would needlessly complicate" the political process. It is "something that cannot be tampered with," he said.

His remarks were in response to questions about reports that France is reportedly planning to

submit an amendment to the resolution which will mention "the right of the Palestinian nation." The French are trying to get their partners in the European Economic Community to support the move. The Palestine Liberation Organization had demanded that the resolution be changed to include the mention of a Palestinian entity. President Carter has said that if the PLO agreed to accept Resolution 242 the U.S. will consider that this is acceptance of the right of Israel to exist and will thus be willing to meet with the PLO.

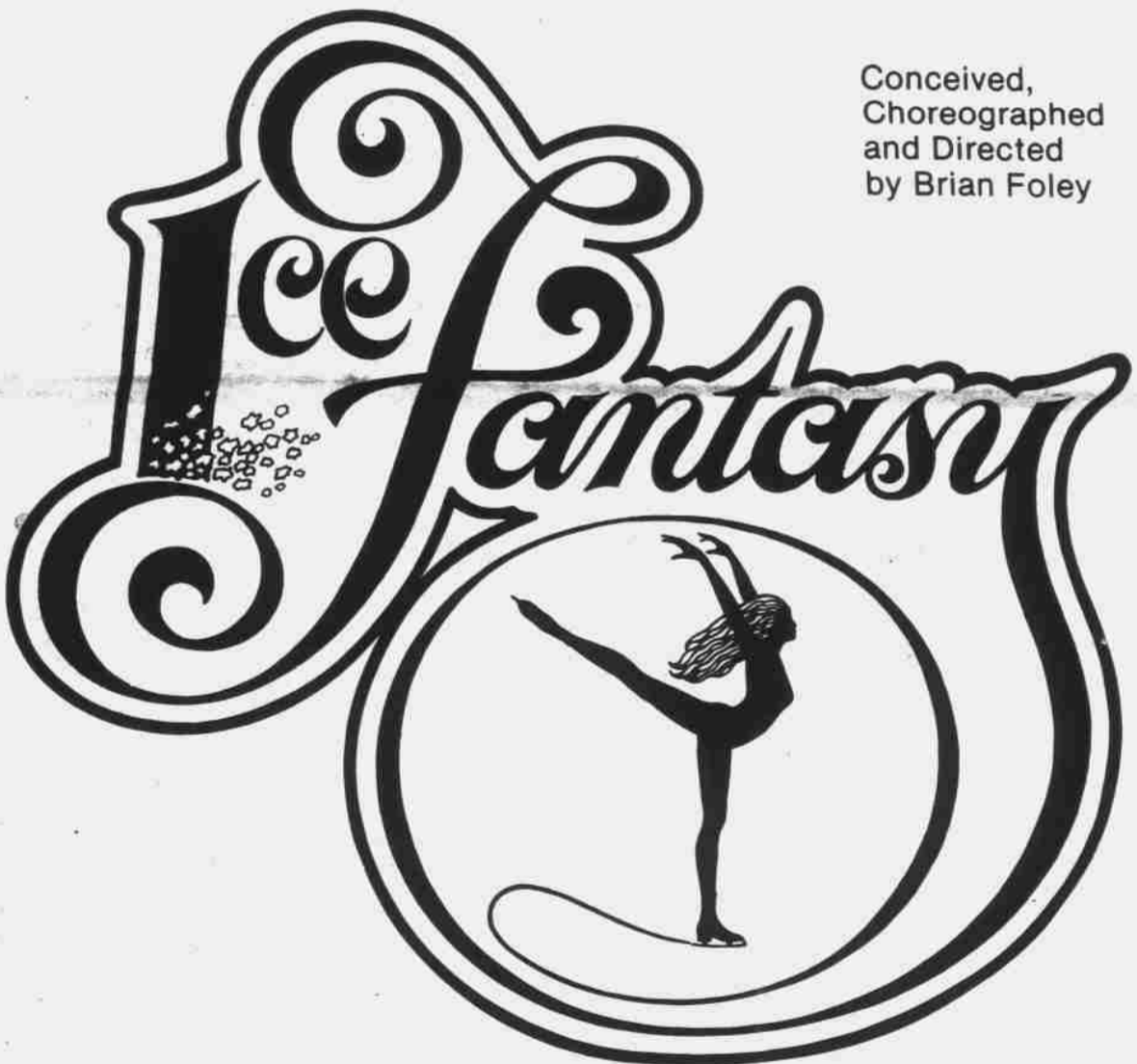
