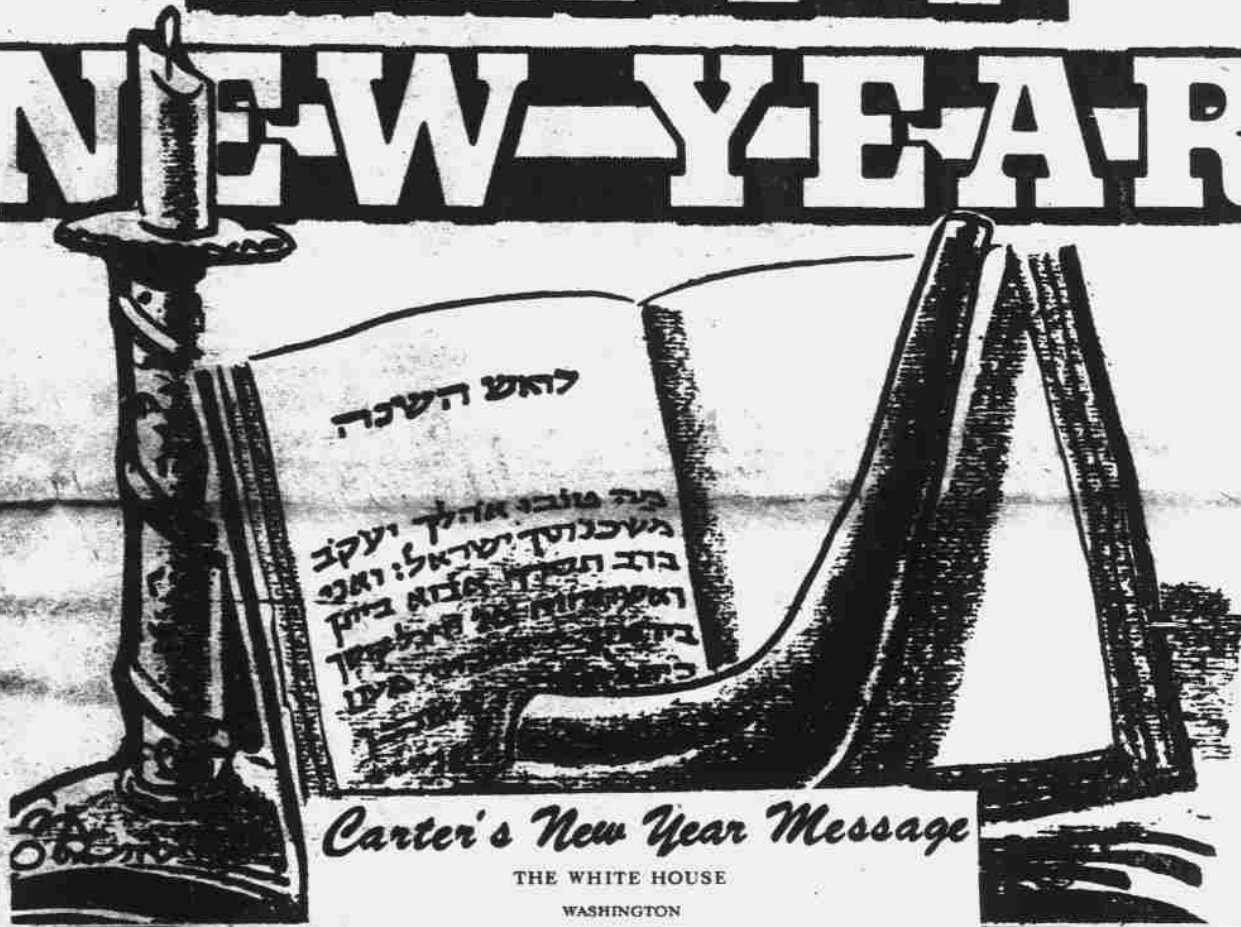

ISRAEL HELPED CHRISTIANS IN LEBANON

NEW YORK (WUP) -- David Halevy, Time Magazine Jerusalem correspondent, has revealed that, during the height of the Lebanese civil war, Israel embarked upon a secret mission involving a rendezvous at sea between Yitzhak Rabin and Shimon Peres with the two most important Lebanese Christian leaders. In the August 22nd issue of Time, Halevy reports that "the secret Israeli operation began in May, 1976 when three Israeli missile boats sailed from Haifa to Jounieh Bay, near the Christian 'capital' north of Beirut. An Explanation of Jewish High Holydays

Every autumn the Jewish people observe what are known as the High Holidays.

This is a period of ten days beginning with Rosh Hashana, which means New Year, and ending with Yom Kippur, the day of Atonement.

The Jewish New Year has nothing to do with the calendar year. Jews regard January the
