

TO ADMIT "GOOD"PLO MEMBERS vern (D, SD) allows the Secretary of State "within 30 days of receiving applications for a non-immigrant visa by any alien who is ex-cludable from the cludable from the United States by reason of membership in or affiliation with a prescribed organization. but who otherwise is otherwise ad-missable to the U.S." to recommend that the Attorney General grant approval for the visa. The only exception would be if the Secretary of State
