

JEWISH NEW YEAR BEGINS SUNDOWN MON.

Las Vegas Jewish community will join their brethren throughout the free world to celebrate Rosh Hashana, the Jewish New Year, beginning at sundown on Monday, September 12, 1977. According to the Hebrew calendar, this begins the year, 5738.

Dan Goldfarb, President of Temple Beth Shalom, stated that Rosh Hashana Services will be conducted at the Temple at 8:00 P.M. on Monday and Tuesday evening, September 12th and 13th; and at 8:30 A.M. on Tuesday and Wednesday morning, September 13th and 14th. Tuesday evening services are designated a "Youth Family Night" and feature the participation of all Temple Youth.

All Services will be conducted and officiated by Rabbi Philip Shnairson, Cantor Joseph Kohn will chant the liturgy assisted by the Temple Adult Choir led by Mr. Morry King. Martha Olson will be at the organ.

The period of ten days - from the first day of Rosh Hashana until the end of Yom Kippur is known as Ten Days of Repentance. These days

of meditation are designed for man to prove his worth. During this period the tradition speaks of mans deeds of the past year being reviewed by God. The shofar (rams horn) which is blown during the Rosh Hashana Service is sounded again at the end of Yom Kippur, the Day of Attonement, marking the end of this Holy Season.

and turn to Moscow where he knew he would find full support for his radical anti - Israel stand.

Reporting on this latest conspiratorial visit, the Christian Science Monitor correspondent in Moscow, David K. Willis, noted that "Soviet anxiety is spurred by the realization that it has lost influence in the Arab world recently" and that "efforts to mend fences with Egypt have failed," wherefore "the Kremlin is using the four - day visit by Arafat to underscore its commitment to a Palestinian state separate from any links to Jordan" as a jab against the U.S., Egypt, Saudi Arabia and Jordan who favor such a link.

There can be no doubt that the latest PLO-directed Palestinian National Council declaration, released in Damascus, was inspired by and had the blessing of the Soviets. It consisted of the following three clauses which can only be understood and interpreted as a warning to Sadat and other Arab leaders not to come to any kind of a negotiated settlement with Israel that would preclude PLO aims:

1. Condemnation of all the U.S. and Zionist maneuvers...the Council reiterates its rejection of any attempt aimed at liquidating the resolutions of the Palestine National Council and to change the Arab attitude, as decided during the Arab summit conferences of Rabat and Cairo. 2. The Council opposes UN resolution 42 which ignores the national rights of our people...and appeals to the Arab nations on both the official and popular levels to live up to the national responsibility and confront the plot forged by those powers that are the enemy of our people, such as Zionism and American imperialism, and to extricate themselves from the confines of hesitation into confrontation. 3. The Council also insisted on the importance of increasing our continuous armed struggle against Zionist usurpation.

In essence, we have here a declaration of war against Israel. Carter must now realize that Prime Minister Menachem Begin has been right all along in his adamant refusal to have any dealings at all with the Palestine Liberation Organization -- whether or not it accepts or rejects 242.
