

# JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

**TEL AVIV (WNS) --** The way to stop Arab terrorists from kidnapping Israelis and holding them hostages is to condemn some of the terrorists now in Israeli jails to death, according to Amichai Paglin, Premier Menachem Begin's advisor on anti-terrorism methods.

**JERUSALEM (WNS) --** The Democratic Movement for Change (DMC) will not be part of the present Likud-led government "under the present circumstances" and will play an active role as an opposition party, Prof. Yigael Yadin declared in a Knesset press conference. He said all negotiations with Likud are terminated.

**JERUSALEM (WNS) --** An emergency plan designed to alleviate the plight of 45,000 Israeli families presently living in slum conditions will be launched following its approval by top United Jewish Appeal and United Israel Appeal leaders, Leon Dulzin Jewish Agency and World Zionist Organization treasurer told the WZO Executive.

**TEL AVIV (WNS) --** Israel's policy on Jewish settlements in the territories will be determined by the full government no individual ministers, Premier Menachem Begin stressed in a series of interviews.

**JERUSALEM (WNS) --** The establishment of a special committee to study ways to deal with the growing problem of crime was approved by the Cabinet.

**NEW YORK (WNS) --** Hebrew Union College-Jewish Institute of Religion will build its New York school on a site adjacent to New York University at Manhattan's Washington Square.

**WASHINGTON (WNS) --** Protestants and Roman Catholics stood in for Jews on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur in the daily vigil opposite the Soviet Embassy.

**JERUSALEM (WNS) --** The Prime Minister's Office has confirmed that Premier Menachem Begin has instructed the police, the secret service and prison officials to refrain from inflicting physical injuries on prisoners during questioning.

**WASHINGTON (WNS) --** The proposed sale of 14 C-130 transport planes and 12 pilotless, radio-controlled reconnaissance aircraft to Egypt is "in the national interest of the United States," Alfred Atherton Assistant Secretary of State for Near Eastern and South Asian Affairs, told the House International Relations Committee.

**LONDON (WNS) --** British Jews are elated that Prime Minister James Callaghan has invited Israeli Premier Menachem Begin to come to Britain.

**AMSTERDAM (WNS) --** Asaf Dayan, the film actor son of Israeli Foreign Minister Moshe Dayan, denounced Premier Menachem Begin and the present Israeli government as "dangerous for Israel." Dayan said he is "afraid of men who trust only in God and not in themselves."

**NEW YORK (WNS) --** Hungarian Jews have a "substantial" degree of freedom to worship, to produce and acquire Jewish scriptures and prayerbooks, and to go to synagogues, according to Evangelist Billy Graham, who has just completed his first crusade in an East European country. Graham said he was told this by Jewish leaders in Budapest.

**NEW YORK (WNS) --** Felix Kamov-Kandel, the Soviet Jewish screenwriter and playwright, has received permission to emigrate along with his family, according to the Greater New York Conference on Soviet Jewry.

**AMSTERDAM (WNS) --** The monumental 70-year-old synagogue building in Groningen, which has stood empty for two years, will become a culture center.

**BRUSSELS (WNS) --** The trial of Ernest Ehlers, former chief of the Nazi political police during World War II, will start in West Germany early next year.

## LAS VEGAS ISRAELITE RUSSIA, ARABS WANT ISRAEL OUT OF 1980 OLYMPICS

**WASH. (WNS) --** At least 80 Democratic and Republican congressmen have urged the U.S. Olympic Committee to block an effort by the Soviet Union and Third World countries to exclude Israel from the 1980 Olympic Summer Games in Moscow.

They signed a letter originated by Rep. Jack Kemp (R.N.) and sent to Robert Kane, president of the Olympic Committee. Kemp told the House that "a combined Soviet-Third World campaign is now underway" against Israel membership in 26 Olympic federations to less than five, the minimum required for participation in the Olympics. "Under pressure from the Soviets and from the Third World nations, the Israelis are being forced out of these federations, one by one and usually on a technicality never otherwise applied," Kemp declared.

The letter urges the U.S. Committee "to undertake every measure possible" to prevent this from occurring. "Popular and financial support for the Olympics will collapse should this exclusion be perpetrated," the letter from the congressmen warned.
