## ISRAEL DENIES SECRET AGREEMENT WITH U.S. ON GENEVA TALKS

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Israelis are trying to sort out fact from fiction regarding reports about a "secret agreement" between the United States and Israel which ostensibly states that no Palestine Liberation Organization members will participate in reconvened Geneva talks and that the issue of a Palestinian state will not be raised at the conference.

Conflicting statements about this so-called secret agreement only tangled further the web of what some here saw as part of a diplomatic intrigue and threatened to complicate relations between Jerusalem and Washington. Yoel Markus, the U.S. correspondent for Haaretz, claimed October 16 that such a document was agreed upon in addition to the U.S. - Israel working paper on Geneva procedure which the Cabinet and Knesset have approved. He also suggested that similar documents may have been signed between the U.S. and the Arab states. Markus attributed his information to "knowledgeable sources."

Israeli officials, along with Foreign Minister Moshe Dayan who allegedly had been involved in drafting the "secret agreement" along with the working paper during his meetings in New (Continued on Page 3)

### Inevitable

Just as certain that night follows day and Saturday comes after Friday, it was inevitable the Sun publisher Hank Greenspun would take credit for the closing of the Desert Inn.

This will be proven beyond doubt when the Desert Inn reopens on July 4, 1978 as the most luxurious hotel on the face of the earth.

Greenspun boasted that the "closing of the hotel was due to its refusal to advertise in the Las Vegas Sun." We'll tell you why Summa does not advertise in the Sun, but first we want to go on about Greenspun's idiotic and insulting (to his readers) reasoning. Without stating a single fact to prove his allegations, Hank, with a straight face to his innocent and naive readers, claims: "As a person dedicated to the prosperity of the Las Vegas business community, it is with total objectivity and sincere business judgement that I alert all businesses the way to success is with the Las Vegas Sun."

He continues: "Some who went exclusively into the little paper down the street soon went out of business."

This is a little different from what U.S. District Judge Samuel Conti ruled in the anti-trust suit brought by Greenspun to get back the advertising when Summa took it away for good solid business reasons. ### HIJACKERS SINGLED OUT JEWS

NEW YORK (WUP) -- As at Entebbe, the Lufthansa hijack-

ers had singled out Jews and Israelis for 'special treatment.'

This fact was revealed by Mrs. Christine Santiago who with her son, Leo, were the only American hostages held by the murderers.

Reporting from Frankfurt, Times correspondent Henry Tanner, who interviewed Mrs. Santiago, cites her as having said that the leader of the hijackers had ordered the hostages to surrender their passports for identification purposes.

"He called out the names of three girls who were Jewish and said that they would be executed in the morning," she told Tanner. "All night the three, as well as the other passengers, were convinced the women were doomed. But then in the morning the hijacker said he would let them live 'just to show that we are freedom fighters and not terrorists.'"
