Meanwhile, Washington appeared to be play-ing a double - edged game: on the one hand it sought publicly to soften and blur differences with Israel over the issue of PLO representa-tion at Geneva; on the other hand, U.S. officials behind the scenes expressed chagrin at Israel's refusal to deal with the PLO or coutenance a Palestinian state. U.S. Administration offi-cials reportedly were satisfied with Dayan's explanation of his talks with President Carter. explanation of his talks with President Carter. At the same time, Hodding Carter sought to dispel reports that the U.S. was perturbed over the publication October 13 by Israel of the working paper. He said he was not prepared to answer whether the U.S. had understood Is-rael was not to make public the working paper until the Arabs had responded to it. However, unofficially, Administration spokesmen expressed irritation that the paper had been published despite the fact that Dayan had earlier promised not to do so, and expressed concern that it will be harder for the Arab countries to agree to the document now that it has been made public.

The Soviet Union has already blasted it as a move to split the Arab ranks.


