

KENNEDY ASSURES 18 FAMILIES OUT OF RUSSIA

WASH. (WNS) -- Soviet authorities will allow 18 Jewish and non-Jewish families, who have been seeking to emigrate for years to leave soon for the United States or Israel. Sen. Edward M. Kennedy (D, Mass.) announced. Kennedy said he had received this assurance during a week-long visit to the Soviet Union which included a meeting with Soviet President Leonid Brezh-

nev. Kennedy said that among those receiving visas will be Prof. Benjamin Levich and his wife, who have been seeking emigration visas to go to Israel since 1972, and Boris and Natashan Katz and their 10-month-old daughter Jessica. The Katz infant suffers from a rare digestive ailment which can be treated only by an American formula which the Boston-based Action for Soviet Jewry has ar-

ranged for the infant to receive. While in the USSR, Kennedy met with Boris Katz. He also met with Ida Milgrom and Leonid Shcharansky, the mother and brother of Anatoly Shcharansky. Dr. Alexander Lerner and Victor Elistratov. Kennedy's announcement was welcomed by representatives of the National Conference on Soviet Jewry (NCSJ) who were at the press con-

ference. Aaron Goldman, former NJCRAC chairman, speaking for the present chairman, Theodore Mann, said the NJCRAC hoped this means the USSR will now not only increase the emigration numbers but end the "arbitrary and capricious handling" of immigration applications.

APPALLING CONDITIONS AT VLADIMIR PRISON

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The Student Struggle for Soviet Jewry has released what it called "a chilling insight" into Vladimir prison where Anatoly Shcharansky will spend the next three years.

If he survives his term in what the SSSJ called "the most notorious" jail in the USSR, he will be sent to a harsh labor camp for another ten years.

The "insight" was provided by Vladimir Bukovsky, a recent inmate of the prison, now in the West. He describes the small cells shared by from three to 10 men in which no light can penetrate. "The walls of the cell are made of rough concrete so they cannot be written on, and are damp," Bukovsky reports. "There is a heating system but part of the punishment is to keep it deliberately low, even in winter. Some cells have no toilets, only a bucket or just a hole in the floor. All the stench from the sewage system returns to the cells, which have no proper ventilation system," Bukovsky said that conditions in special punishment cells are even worse and that prisoners in solitary get reduced diets.

"The appalling conditions in Vladimir means that almost
