going ahead with its program for Jewish settlements on the West Bank but it would not bow to pressure from Gush Emunim to speed up the pace.

Begin's remarks came during a stormy four - hour meeting of the Likud Knesset faction called to discuss the recent attempts by the Gush to set up new settlements on the West Bank. Shortly after the meeting several members of of Gush Emunim were arrested when they blocked the Nablus - Tulkarem road with some 20 vehicles. There were reports of fist fights between the Gush demonstrators and West Bank motorists who had been held up by the demonstration.

Begin told the meeting that his government had erected "many Elon Morehs" (Kadum) as he had promised when he visited Kadum after the Likud victory in the May, 1977 elections. "We have opened Samaria to Jewish settlements," he said. He claimed that during the 10 years before Likud came to power the Labor government had kept the area "ideologically closed." Gush Emunim was supported in the meeting by hardline MKs Geula Cohen and Moshe Shamir; Moshe Arens, the chairman of the Foreign Affairs and Defense Committee, and Yigal Hurwitz, the former minister who resigned in opposition to the Camp David agreements.

Little Cory Matthew Berger is just one of millions of Jewish babies who have been circumcised during the past 4000 years.

But Master Cory had the rare distinction recently of being circumcised over the telephone, long - distance, with Rabbi Stephen E. Weisberg, of Congregation Ner Tamid, Las Vegas, officiating. A rarity, to say the least! The Berger family lives in Lake Havasu, Arizona, which has neither Rabbi nor Synagogue. There is a small Jewish community, and most of the residents are friends of the Bergers. This past Dec. 28 at 7:00 a.m., they all gathered at the Berger home to celebrate little Cory's B'RIT MILAH -- the traditional Hebrew term for the ceremony of welcome into the "Covenant of Abraham." And a great cause for celebration.

It was Abraham, according to Rabbi Weisberg, whom GOD had first commanded concerning the observance of circumcision. In the Torah (the five Books of Moses, and the basic Consti-
