warned against losing patience or confidence in the peace process. Begin reportedly used the same tone when he met with U.S. Ambassador Samuel Lewis Jan. 10. But he also said there should be assurances, as far as possible, that the talks would be successful. Foreign Minister Moshe Dayan, meanwhile, told the visiting British group that Western Europe should have been more energetic in its support of Egyptian President Anwar Sadat's peace initiative. He said Sadat needed this support to counterbalance the pressure he was receiving from parts of the Arab world.

### ISRAEL NEEDS NATIONAL UNITY PARTY

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Former British Prime Minister Harold Wilson said here Jan. 10 that Israel needs a government of national unity in order to meet the issue of the West Bank and the Gaza Strip. told a press conference, held under the auspices of the American Technion Society that the hardest problem faced by Premier Menachem Begin is the future of the Jewish settlements on the West along with a freeze on new ones. Wilson said that many Israeli and foreign observers have told him that such a government is needed. He praised President Carter for his

accomplishments at the Camp David meeting, but declared that any Middle East settle-

ment must be reached by bilateral negotiations between Israel and Egypt. He rejected the notion that pressure could be applied on either Israel or Egypt. "I don't think that anyone outside is in a position to force a settlement," he said.
