decision is not new and was taken "several weeks ago" and provided for Nahal outposts near Jericho, north of the Jordan Valley and south of the Gaza Strip. There have been unconfirmed reports that President Carter plans to send Begin an angry letter over this.

Carter, meanwhile, said in a television interview broadcast Jan. 17 that he believes that the final issue disputed between Egypt and Israel will have to be decided in a face-to-face meeting between Begin and Egyptian President Anwar Sadat before a peace treaty can be signed. He said he preferred that the issues would be settled on the foreign ministerial level but would consider another summit if necessary. At the same time he stressed the U.S. was not promoting any particular settlement between the two sides and would accept any settlement that both Egypt and Israel found mutually agreeable whether it was reached between the two countries alone or with the aid of the U.S. He said the U.S. only offers proposals when neither Israel nor Egypt can agree.

**IRANIAN LEADER NOT ANTI-SEMITIC**

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Two Israeli journalists who met with an associate of Iranian religious leader Ayatollah Khomeini said they were told that a new Islamic regime in Iran would maintain relations with Israel if the Jewish State agreed to a solution of the Palestinian issue in accordance with United Nations Resolutions.

Dr. Ibrahim Yazdi, a senior advisor to Khomeini, told correspondents of Maariv and Al Hamishmar in France that the only quarrel Ayatollah's anti-Shah movement has with Israel is over the Palestinians who have lost their land and Israel's alleged aid to Savak, the Shah's hated secret police. Other advisors told the Israeli journalists that the Ayatollah was not anti-Semitic and that he had received

a delegation of Iranian Jews. Khomeini, in an interview on CBS-TV's "Face the Nation" Jan 14 declared that "We are against Israel and we will never help Israel. We will cut off all diplomatic relations." However, he said he did not know whether Iran would join Arabs in a war against Israel.

But he stressed that Jews and other religious minorities in Iran "can live freely, and under the Islamic government even their freedom will be much better and greater than un-

der the Shah's regime." Meanwhile, the Jewish Agency has been forced to close

its office in Teheran because of anti-Israel and anti-Jewish threats.

**U.S. INVESTMENTS INCREASE 50%**

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Two Israeli economic experts reported here Jan. 17 that United States investments in Israel totaled \$120 million in 1978, a 50 percent increase over the preceding year.

"In 1978, many more American companies realized that Israel is an ideal location for their research and development and high technology operations," it was stressed at a press conference by Uriel Lynn, director general of the Government of Israel Investment Authority for North America.

Both Lynn, and Dr. Zvi Dinstein, Israel's economic minister to the U.S. and Canada, attributed the increase to the liberalization of the Israeli economy in an effort to move

toward a free market system, including total elimination of foreign currency controls for foreign investors; the weakening of the impact of the Arab boycott against Israel because of the U.S.

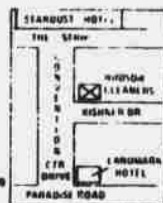
