DAYAN WARNS ARABS IN ISRAEL AGAINST ISLAMIC FANATICISM

CARTER DETERMINED TO ACHIEVE PEACE

WASH. (WNS) -- President Carter stressed the determination to help achieve a peacetreaty between Israel and

Egypt. "I am determined to use the full beneficial influence of our nation so that the precious opportunity for lasting peace between Israel and Egypt will not be lost," he said in his State of the Union speech before a joint session of Congress. The President's references to the Mid-east were brief in the 40 - minute address.

"In the Middle East -- under the most difficult circumstances we have sought to help the ancient enemies lay aside deep - seated differences that have produced four bitter wars in this century," the President said. "Our firm commitment to Israel's survival and security is rooted in our deep convictions and in our knowledge of the strategic importance of our nation of a stable Middle East. To promote peace and reconciliation in the region, we must retain the trust and confidence both of Israel and of the Arab nations.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Arabs in Israel and on the West Bank were warned not to be "carried away by the Islamic fanaticism" now growing in the Middle East or they would "pay very dearly for it."

The warning was from Foreign Minister Moshe Dayan in an address to U.S. and Canadian Jews participating in the 1979 Prime Minister's Israel Bonds Mission.

It came after public expressions of support for the Palestine Liberation Organization by some 200 Arab dignitaries in Nazareth. Dayan said that Israeli Arabs should "remember 1948" when they threw away the chance for peace and a Palestinian state. "We are not the Shah," he said. "We are not foreign rulers here." He said Israel wanted to live together with the Palestinians but if they were "not satisfied" and sought to "replace Israel with an Islamic concept" they would "have to pay very dearly indeed."

Dayan also said that the Islamic ferment, especially the Iranian situation, would make the attempt to reach an agreement with Egypt "no easier or simpler." He said Egypt is now more anxious to prove to other Arab states that it is not making a "separate deal" with Israel or abandoning the Arab cause.

He said Israel's defense concerns are more crucial than ever and it must increase the number of settlements and settlers in existing settlements in the Jordan Valley, the West Bank and Gaza Strip. "Both Israel and Egypt will have to make an effort to understand each other's considerations and concerns in the light of current regional events," he said.

300,000 AMERICANS VISITED ISRAEL

NEW YORK -- In Tourism, Israel's 1978, 292,794 Americans visited Israel, an 8% increase over 1977, making it the best year ever for American tourism to Israel. Almost 1.1 million tourists from around the world visited the country in 1978, nine - percent more than the previous year's record total.

The United States is the number one source of Israel's tourism, followed by West Germany, France and Great Britain.
