The warning was from Foreign Minister Moshe Dayan in an address to U.S. and Canadian Jews participating in the 1979 Prime Minister's Israel Bonds Mission.

It came after public expressions of support for the Palestine Liberation Organization by some 200 Arab dignitaries in Nazareth. Dayan said that Israeli Arabs should "remember 1948" when they threw away the chance for peace and a Palestinian state. "We are not the Shah," he said. "We are not foreign rulers here." He said Israel wanted to live together with the Palestinians but if they were "not satisfied" and sought to "replace Israel with an Islamic they would "have to pay very dearly concept" indeed."

Dayan also said that the Islamic ferment, especially the Iranian situation, would make the attempt to reach an agreement with Egypt "no easier or simpler." He said Egypt is now more anxious to prove to other Arab states that it is not making a "separate deal" with Israel or abandoning the Arab cause.

He said Israel's defense concerns are more crucial than ever and it must increase the number of settlements and settlers in existing settlements in the Jordan Valley, the West Bank and Gaza Strip. "Both Israel and Egypt will have to make an effort to understand each other's considerations and concerns in the light. of current regional events," he said.


In early afternoon the temperature rose to about 40 and all returned to normal.
