

JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Two persons were killed and more than 50 injured when a bomb exploded in Netanya's crowded Zion Square Jan. 28.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- If Quebec were to become independent of Canada it would recognize Israel and favor an "entity" for Palestinian Arabs, Quebec Premier Rene Levesque said here Jan. 28.

UNITED NATIONS (WNS) -- The General Assembly adopted two resolutions Jan. 24 condemning Israel for its relations with South Africa.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Rabbi Sol Roth, first vice president of the Rabbinical Council of America urged Jewish federations in the United States to do more to help finance the education of the children of Soviet immigrants.

CINCINNATI (WNS) -- American Jews are not "yes men" for either Washington or Jerusalem, it was maintained here by Theodore R. Mann, chairman of the National Jewish Community Relations Advisory Council (NJCRAG). "American Jews are a free and independent community whose reactions to any issue of concern are guided by a sense of responsibility," he told the 400 American Jewish community leaders attending the NJCRAG's plenary meeting.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- "The present form of the Equal Rights Amendment (ERA) represents a potential danger to the entire religious community of the United States," especially the religious schools in which the sexes are separated, Rabbi Bernard Rosensweig, president of the Rabbinical Council of America, warned.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- The American ORT Federation has adopted a record budget of \$78,110,000 for 1979 to provide educational and other services for 100,000 men, women and young people in 24 countries.

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- Taking strong objection to a UN resolution condemning Israel with "collaboration with the apartheid regime of South Africa," Israel's Ambassador Yehudah Z. Blum, in a speech delivered at the resumed Assembly's debate on apartheid, charged that the whole UN performance was "not in a process of deliberation, but in a ritualistic incantation which has severely undermined the very purpose of the annual debate on apartheid."

NEW YORK (WUP) -- The American ORT Federation, which held its 1979 national convention at the Hilton Hotel here last week, is planning to commemorate ORT's 100th anniversary in Israel next year.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Some 100 Iranian Jews are waiting at Teheran Airport to leave Iran, according to Iranian Jews who arrived here Jan. 31 from the Iranian capital.

BUCHAREST (WNS) -- Rumanian Chief Rabbi Moses Rosen has called for the extradition to Rumania of Bishop Valerian Trifa, of Grass Lake, Michigan, and father Vasile Boldeanu of Paris, the two men he holds responsible for the January 1941 massacre of Bucharest's Jewish community.

WASHINGTON (WNS) -- Joyce Starr, associate special assistant to President Carter at the White House, has been named coordinator of the study mission to Israel and Egypt formed by Georgetown University's Center for Strategic and International Studies.

TEL AVIV (WNS) -- Six Israeli Arab students at Hebrew University were ordered back to their home villages in the Galilee after they had expressed support for the Palestine Liberation Organization.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Rabbi Marc H. Tanenbaum, national inter-religious affairs director of the American Jewish Committee, has received a letter from Pope John Paul II's personal secretary, G. Caprio, expressing the Pope's satisfaction with the "growing relations between the Roman Catholic Church and the Jewish religion, in the wake of the Second Vatican Council."

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Sally Preisand, the first woman rabbi in the United States, has resigned as associate rabbi of the Stephen Wise Synagogue in Manhattan. She joined the Reform synagogue in August, 1972, as assistant rabbi and became an associate rabbi two years ago.

LOS ANGELES (WNS) -- The Rabbinical Assembly, the association of Conservative rabbis, has broken with a 30-year tradition by voting to seek aid for its religious schools.

IRANIAN JEWS HAVE NO COMPLAINTS

LOS ANGELES (WNS) -- "Everything is all right in our Jewish community, baruch hashem," Rabbi David Shofer told the 79th annual convention of the Rabbinical Assembly by telephone from Teheran.

"Nothing has happened to any Jew," Shofer, a native of Iran and a graduate of the Jewish Theological Seminary, said after being called by the RA that the "situation in Iran is not clear" but "most of the community believes things are all right."
