He said one of the main points of contention, Article VI of the treaty which deals with the priority of obligations toward Egypt's other treaties with Arab states, is the "heart of the treaty."

said he Carter would not answer any questions on the Middle East. Carter said after receiving Begin's letter he had spoken to both Begin and Sadat by telephone. He said "I have spent more time and inmore of my vested personal effort" on trying to reach a peace than on any other problem. He warned that "If we allow prospects for peace in the Middle East to continue to dim and, perhaps to die, the future at best is unpredictable.
