An early opponent of the Vietnamese war he and some Christian clergymen visited Ho Chi Minh and elicited from him an invitation to Lyndon Johnson to come to Hanoi to settle the conflict amicably. Of course, Washington scorned the idea (which would have saved thousands of lives).

After what his admirers laughingly call retirement, Dr. Feinberg went to San Francisco where he was (get this!) rabbi in residence at the Glide Presbyterian Church!

Now he lives in Reno and, without pay, he is crooning again on the radio, lecturing at colleges, agitating for better treatment of the geriatric.

WEST POINT JEWISH CHAPEL FUND GOES NATIONAL

NEW YORK -- Herbert M. Ames, President of the West Point Jewish Chapel Fund, has been advised by President Jimmy Carter's staff that the President will meet with him and other officers of the Chapel Fund at the White House.

Edgar M. Bronfman, who serves as Chairman of a \$5.5 million campaign to build a chapel at the Military Academy, will announce that the campaign has entered its national phase. To date, \$900,000 has been raised toward the construction of a building that will include a sanctuary and a gallery - museum in which decorations and other items pertaining to Jewish service in every war fought by the United States will be displayed.

Unlike Catholic and Protestant cadets at the United States Military Academy, Jewish cadets have never had a house of worship. Moreover, 4000 non - Jewish cadets -- and two and a half million Ameri-

can and foreign visitors each year -- have few opportunities to learn about Jewish contributions to America's defense and civilization. In order to rectify this situation, a building to include a sanctuary, a library, and a gallery - museum will be constructed.

In essence, the objective is to construct and to endow a Jewish Chapel. In a broader sense, the objectives are to reaffirm the confidence American Jews have in the armed forces of their nation.
