NEW YORK (WNS) American -- The Jewish Committee has sent a proposed guideline to 187 leading colleges and universities aimed at preventing those schools from agreeing to discripractices minatory or biased courses in accepting foreign money, it was announced here March 7.

Ira Silverman, director of special programs for the AJCommittee, said there were no objections to "legitimate" pro-grams for the study of the Arab or Islamic world.

But he pointed out, that some contributions by Arab countries have specified that Israel be not included in a program of studies on the Middle East and have resulted in slanted courses and lecturers. He said another problem was raised when several American universities have rejected programs under Arab sponsorbecause they

would have had to potential donors be exclude Jewish personnel.

The proposed guidewould have lines the university or colstate that it lege not discrimiwill nate on the grounds of race, sex, religion or national in hiring or assigning personnel or in the administration of grants, contracts, or other agreements with foreign entities and will not allow these entities discriminateagainst the school's personnel.

The school would also agree not to discriminate in the admission of students to the programs. It will also not accept any grant, con-tract or other agreement which would require it to cancel programs or other contracts with any foreign country. The **AJCommittee** regiven a copy of the guidelines and that the university assign an officer to the responsibility monitoring com-plaints with the guidelines.
