

# JEWISH NEWS BRIEFS

PHOENIX, Ariz. -- (WNS) -- A leader of Reform Judaism urged American Jews not to just see Israel as "an object of philanthropy and as a refuge for homeless Jews" but also as a place for their own aliya.

KANSAS CITY, Mo. (WNS) -- City Councilman Richard L. Berkley, a businessman and Jewish community leader, has become the first Jew ever elected as mayor of Kansas City.

JERUSALEM (WNS) -- Bombings in Israel and France appeared to be the immediate reaction of terrorists to the signing of a peace treaty between Israel and Egypt.

TEL AVIV -- Israeli Premier Menachem Begin will visit Cairo April 2.

PARIS (WNS) -- Two prominent Iranian Jews were arrested and are being held in Teheran's special prison for political suspects. The two are Habib el Ghanian, the former President of the Iranian Jewish community and Ruhollah Ray, a prominent businessman.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Israeli Premier Menachem Begin has called for open borders between Israel and Egypt.

NEW YORK -- A major program of charter flights to Israel will be inaugurated April 9th from New York's Kennedy Airport.

NEW YORK -- American physicians are invited to participate in the 11th World Assembly of the Israel Medical Association in cooperation with the International Health Society, which will be held in Tel Aviv and Jerusalem May 20 - 25, 1979.

NEW YORK -- The eleventh INTERNATIONAL HAPOEL GAMES, (held every four years) will take place in Israel from May 1 - 8, 1979.

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- A Black African delegate representing one of the major states in Africa told the World Union Press this week that, as a result of the Egyptian-Israeli Peace Treaty, many African countries which severed their diplomatic relations with Israel after the 1967 war, are now seriously considering re-establishing those relations. "They are re-thinking their positions," the delegate stated.

UNITED NATIONS (WUP) -- Isiah the great Prophet was resurrected at the peace signing White House ceremony as the three leaders, Carter, Sadat and Begin included in their speeches the famous Isaiah peace passage which is engraved on the huge wall on the First Avenue Plaza facing the United Nations. "And they shall beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning-hooks. Nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war anymore."

NEW YORK (WUP) -- Reuters reports that, following a visit before the Senate Foreign Relations Committee last week, President Sadat replied to a query by a reporter on the issue of the Holy City with the statement: "I agreed at Camp David that Jerusalem shall not be divided again by barbed wire. But this shall not cancel Moslem rights, the rights of 700 million Moslems."

DALLAS (WNS) -- President Carter gave the broadcast media much credit for the Egyptian - Israeli peace treaty. Carter said he wondered whether the people of Israel and Egypt would have been as ready to accept peace with each other "if they had not been able to see each other's faces on television or hear each other's voices on radio."

WINNIPEG (WNS) -- Philip Klutznick, president of the World Jewish Congress, announced March 27 that the Egyptian Jewish community will be invited to affiliate with the WJC now that the Israeli - Egyptian peace treaty is a reality.

NEW YORK (WNS) -- Premier Menachem Begin announced here that he has invited Theodore Mann, chairman of the Conference of Presidents of Major American Jewish Organizations, to accompany him to Cairo April 2 as the representative of the American Jewish community.
