

Jewish Renewal

"Jewish Renewal," the theme of the current United Jewish Appeal campaign, is also an appropriate message for Passover. The UJA theme is a call for financial support for Jewish individuals, programs and institutions in Israel, the United States and elsewhere. It is also a call for the funds to help pay for "Project Renewal," the innovative program to rehabilitate some 160 slum areas throughout Israel.

For Passover, "Jewish Renewal" means this and much more. Passover, which marks the birth of the Jewish nation, should challenge each

individual Jew to strengthen his commitment to the Jewish people. "In every generation each individual is bound to regard himself as if he had gone personally from Egypt....," commands the Haggadah which Jews read at the Seder. The same passage goes on to say that God "brought us" out of slavery in Egypt so "that He might give us the land which He swore unto our ancestors."

Interpreting this in terms of today's world, it means it is imperative that Jews provide economic, political and moral support for the State of Israel. This support by American Jews must not diminish now that an Egyptian-Israeli peace treaty is a reality. Peace itself has not yet been achieved and Israel's security is still not assured.

The political and moral support of American Jewry for Israel will be needed even more in the struggle ahead to make the treaty lead to real peace, a peace that will also include Israel's other Arab neighbors who so far continue to reject the treaty. Economic support will also be needed, perhaps even more than before. Israel's economic problems are not over and will perhaps be increased now. The problem of the "Second Israel," which "Project Renewal" tries to meet, has not been solved.

"Jewish Renewal" also means supporting Jewish life and institutions outside of Israel. Above all it means expanding and improving Jewish education. Jews must seek education for themselves and especially see to it that their children are provided with a sound Jewish education.

For the individual Jew, Passover offers a challenge for renewed determination to participate fully in every aspect of Jewish life.
