PASSOVER QUESTIONS & ANSWERS.

Q. What is CHOMETZ?

A. This is a general term for all leavened foods. Foods and drinks made from wheat, rye, barley, oats, spelt, as well as derivatives of these grains. Rice, corn, peas, and all types of legumes are forbidden for Passover use. Grain vinegar or whiskey is an example of a derivative food which is Chometz.

Q. To what time may Chometz be eaten this year?

A. Chometz may not be eaten after 9:30 a.m. of Erev Pesach, which this year is Wednesday, April 11.
