## JUSTICE DEPT. TO PROSECUTE MAZIS

WASH. (WNS) --Associate Attorney General Michael Egan has announced that a special investigating unit to hunt and prosecute Nazi war criminals living in the United States has been moved from the Immigration and Naturalization Service to the criminal division of the Justice

Department. The Department will fund the unit with \$2 million appropriated for this fiscal year instead of the \$900,000 allocated by the INS. Rep. Elizabeth Holtzman (D. NY), chairman of the House Judiciary subcommittee dealing with the investigation of Nazis.

expressed satisfaction with the move. Egan had agreed to meet the quirements set by the subcommittee which had long accused the federal government of moving slowly and inadequately on the problem.

The new funds means that the special unit which now has 13 persons. will have 38 lawyers, investigators and other personnel. The subcommittee said no new cases have been since August, filed 1977. There are presently 12 cases in litigation and 175 being more are investigated. Holtzman said she was "gratified that the Department Justice is committed to fully funding and staffing the special litigation unit and to removing bureaucratic obstacles which have hindered its tiveness." effec-She said that if the Justice Department's commitments are kept, result be the most centrated and intensive effort since World War II to bring Nazi war criminals to justice."
